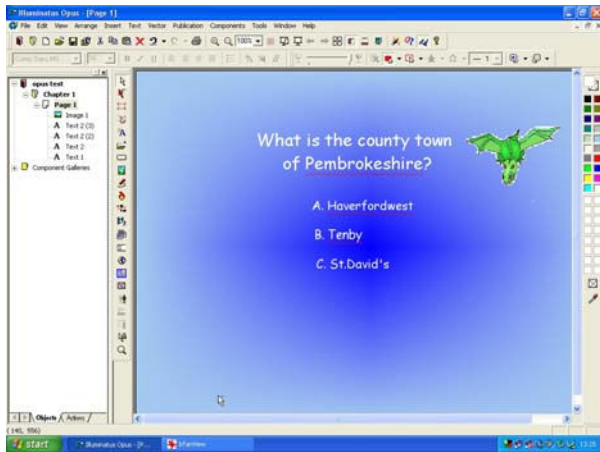
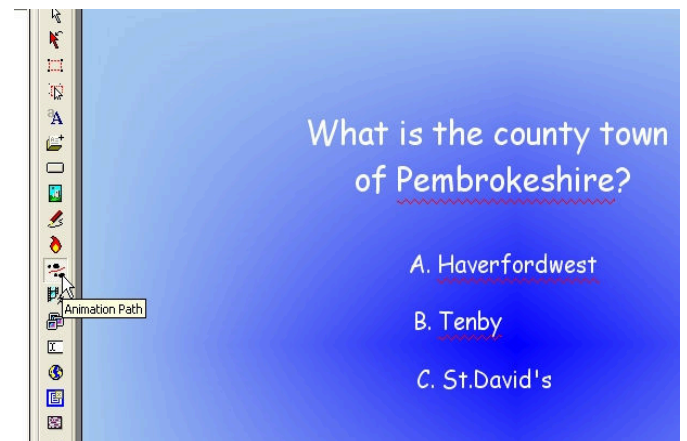


Animation in Illuminatus Opus

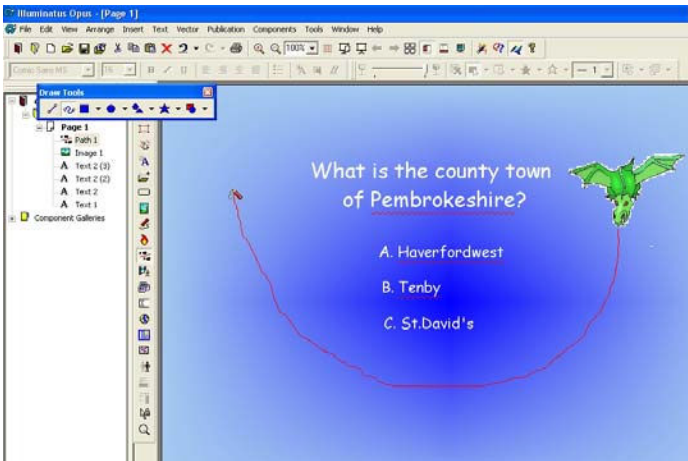
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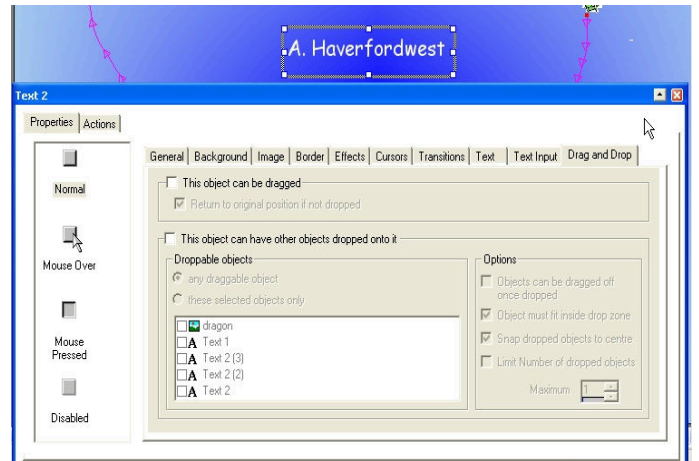
1. Here's one example of how to use animation in Opus. When the user clicks on the right answer, I want the dragon to fly around the screen.



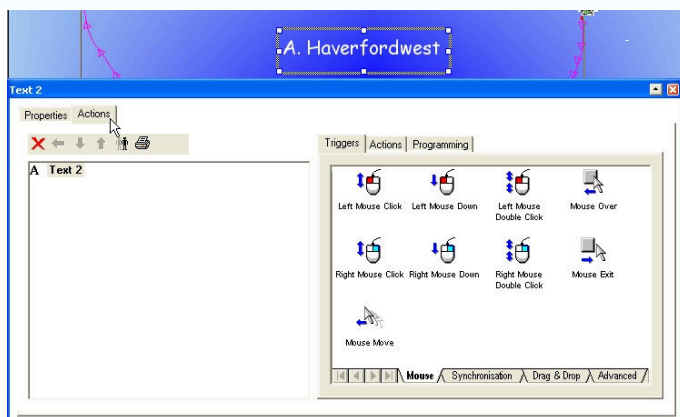
2. To do this you need to draw an animation path. This is a line that the image can follow. Click on the Animation Path tool on the right of the screen.



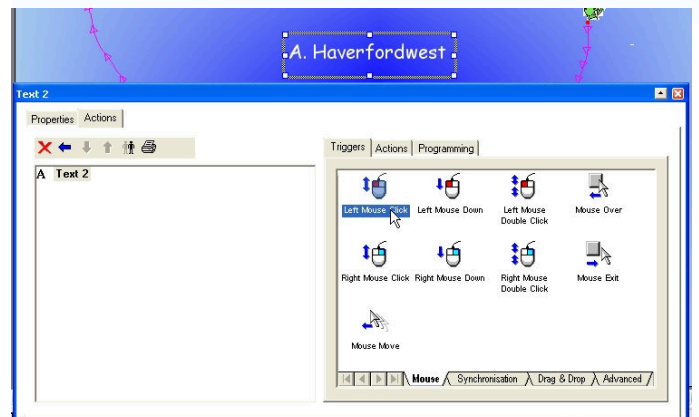
3. Click and hold the left mouse button in the place where you want the line to start, then drag out and draw the line.



4. Now to make something happen. Click twice on the text box that contains the correct answer to open the properties box for that text box.



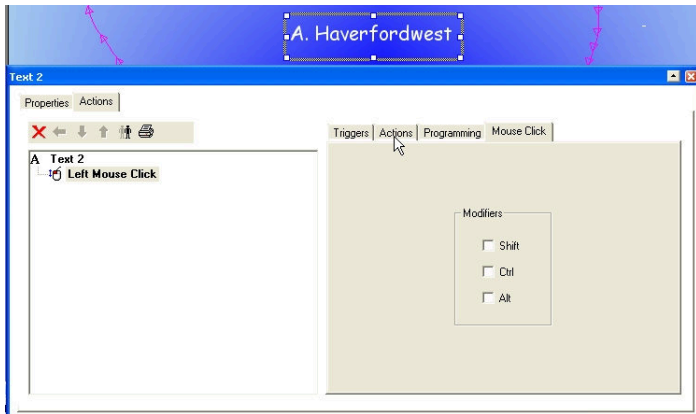
5. Click on the Actions tab.



6. Click twice on Left Mouse Click.

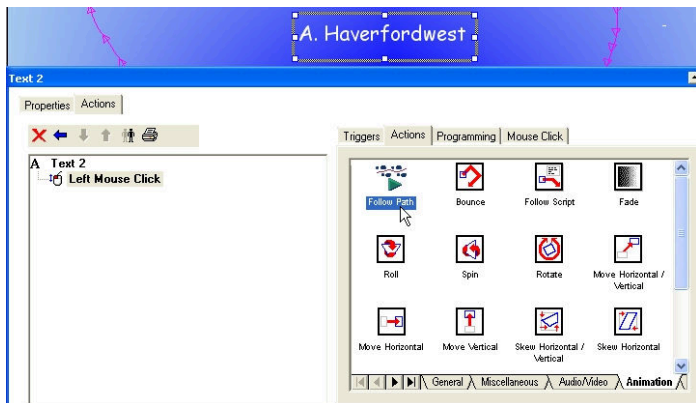
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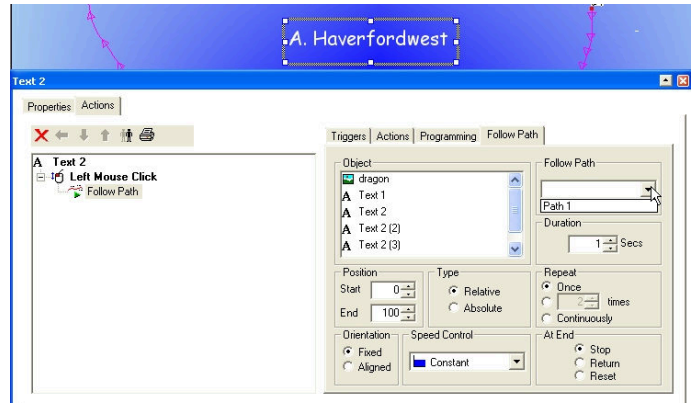
7. Click on the Actions tab on the right-hand side.



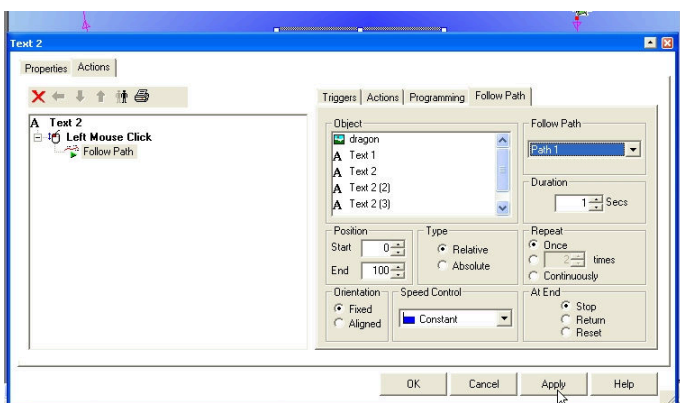
8. Click on the Animation tab below.



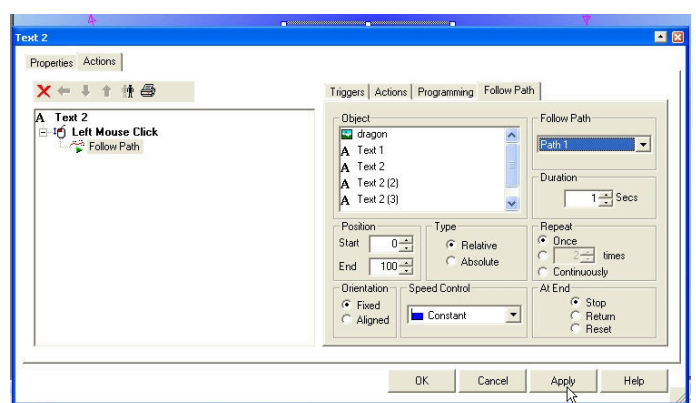
9. Click twice on Follow Path.



10. In the box on the right labelled Follow Path, click on the arrow pointing down to the right of the box.



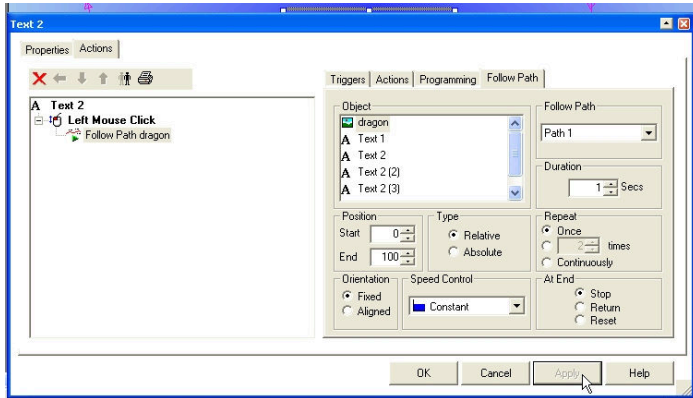
11. Click on the animation path, in this case it is called Path 1. Now its name should be visible in the box.



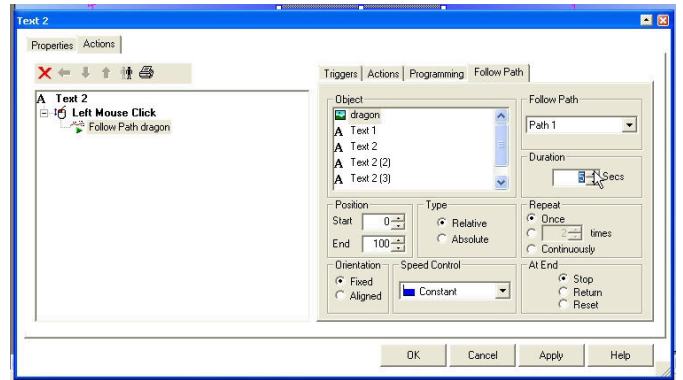
12. Click on Apply.

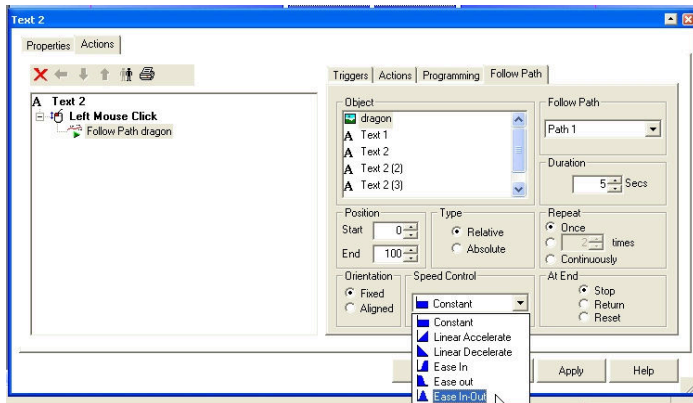
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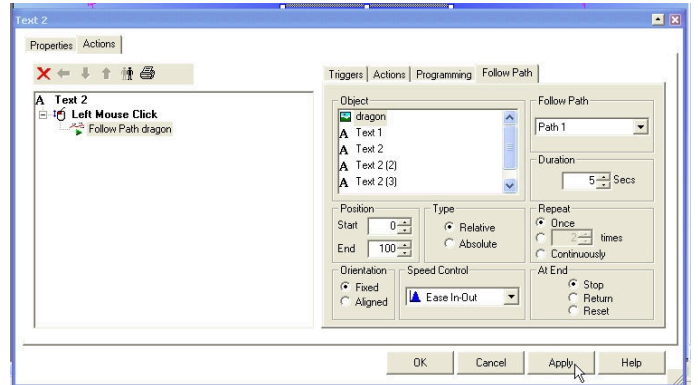
13. In the box labelled Object click on the object that you want to follow the animation path. In this case it is the image called 'dragon'. Click on Apply.



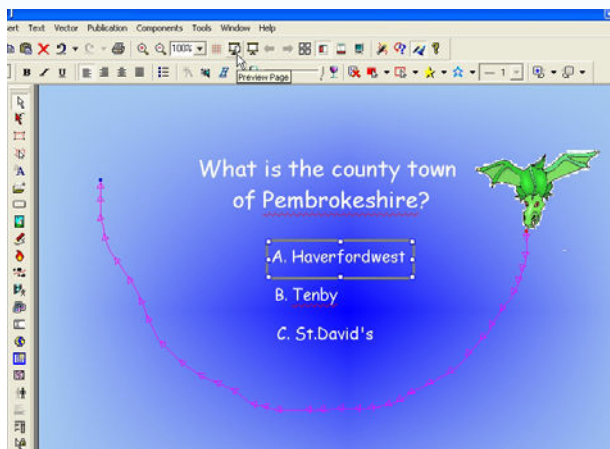
14. In the box labelled Duration you can choose how many seconds it will take for the object to follow the animation path. I have chosen 5 seconds here.



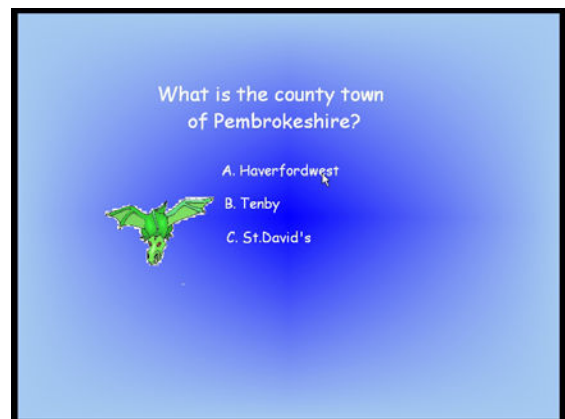
15. The box labelled Speed Control allows you to change the speed at the object moves along the path. Here I have chosen Ease In Out so that the dragon starts slowly, speeds up, then slows down.



16. Click on Apply. There are other options you can explore in the Follow Path control box—but that's enough for now!



17. To test the page, click on Preview at the top of the screen.



18. In Preview, when the user clicks on the correct answer, the dragon 'flies' around the screen. Trust me, it really did work!
