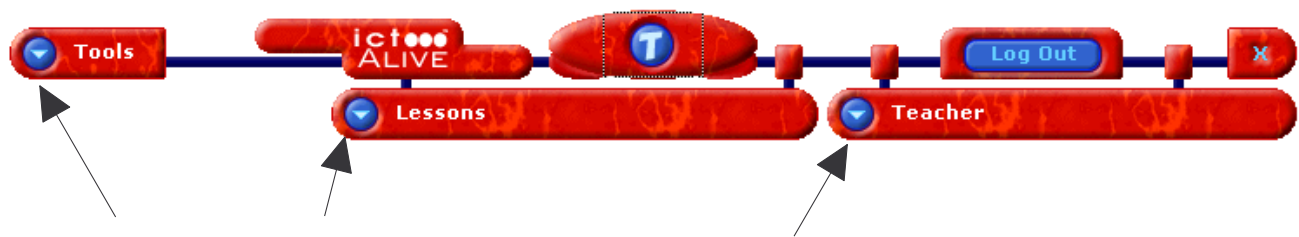


ICT Alive

ICT Alive is a complete ICT resource for primary schools. It covers the curriculum for ICT at key stage 1 and key stage 2 and is closely aligned to the QCA scheme of work. It provides structured materials to allow teachers to plan, prepare, teach and assess ICT lessons. There are 31 units of work covering years 1 - 6. Each unit had 4 - 7 structured lessons and each lesson contains a unit opener, lesson starter, ICT skills, 3 differentiated lesson activities and a plenary session. Each unit ends with an integrated task using the skills learnt in the unit for assessment. ICT Alive has been developed to support teachers who lack confidence in ICT, to provide inspiration for teaching ICT and to provide new ideas and help with assessment for all teachers.

Using ICT Alive

- * Log onto ICT Alive by double clicking the icon on the desktop
- * The ICT Alive tool bar will open.

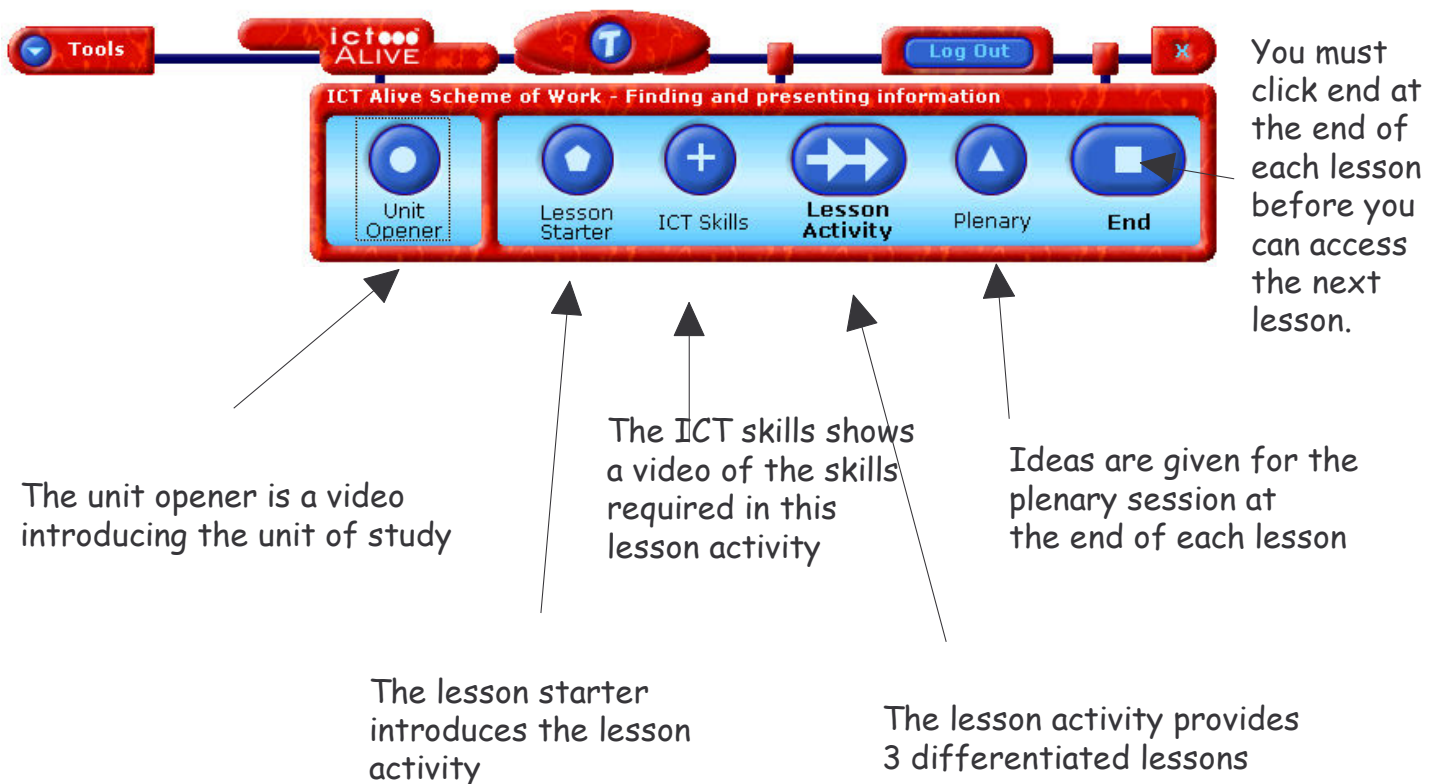


- * Click on the blue arrows to open the tool bars

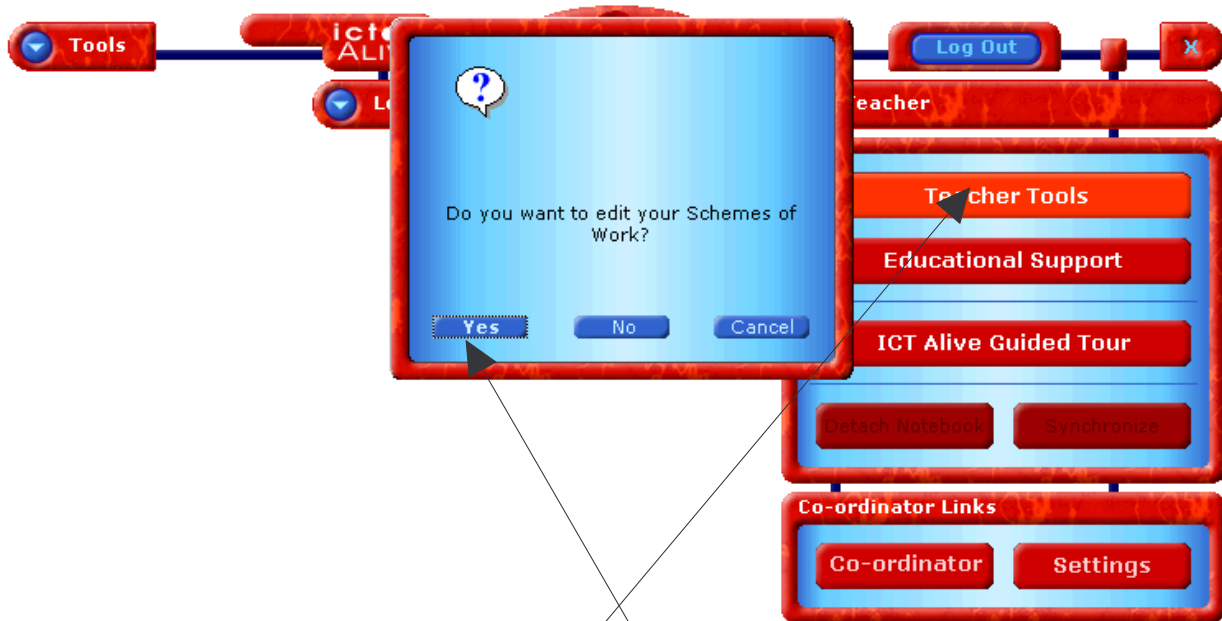


- ★ To log onto the teachers area you will need to enter your user name and password. You will need to obtain your user name and password from your ICT coordinator.
- ★ The tools allow you to use a variety of programs with the children without any pre prepared lessons activities.
- ★ The lessons allow you to log onto your class and will have a lesson already created for you.
- ★ The teacher tools provide you with an overlook of the lesson activities, the detailed lesson plans and assessment and reporting opportunities.

- ★ Click on your class to access the lesson activity

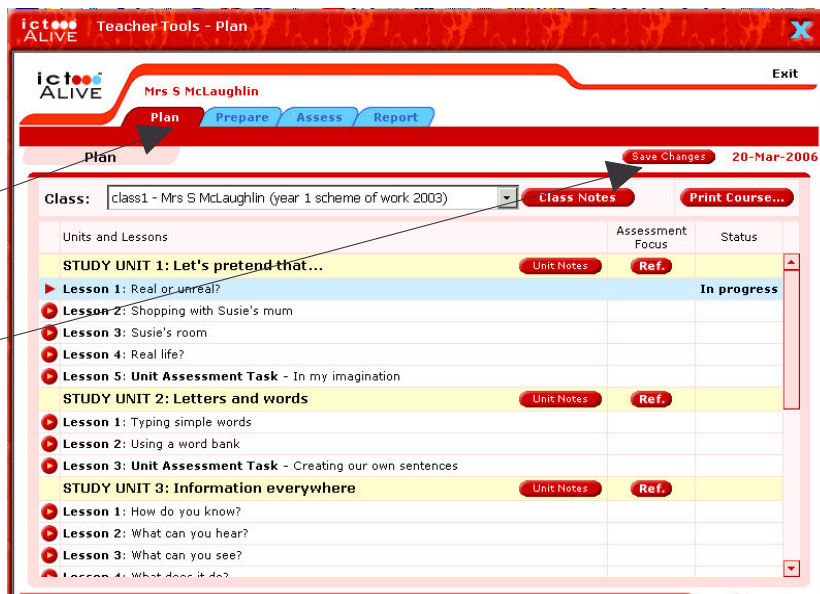


- ★ To access the lesson plans and to have an overview of the lesson activities you must log onto the teachers area. This requires a user name and password.



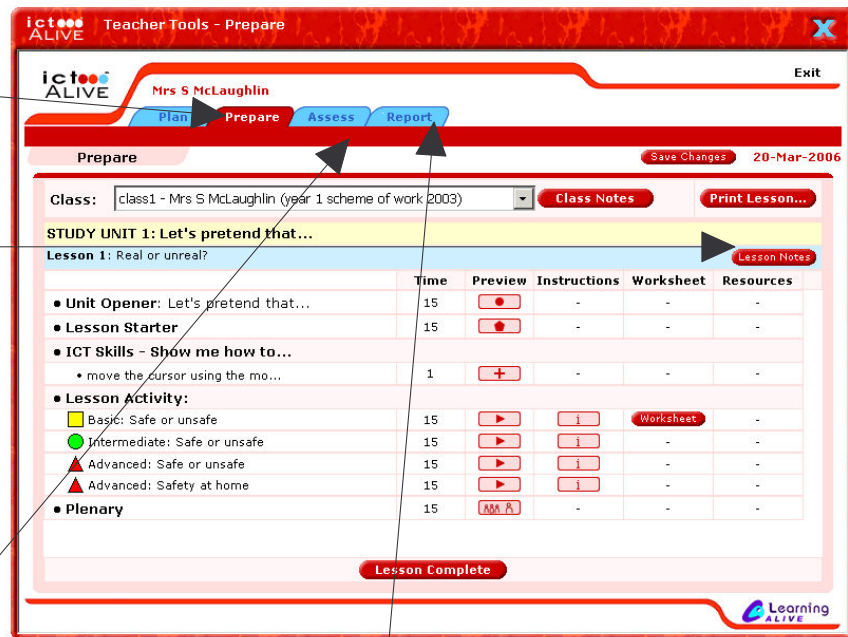
- * Click on teacher tools
- * Select 'yes' to editing your scheme of work
- * This will enable you to select the next lesson activity for your class
- * The following screen will open

The plan screen gives you an overview of all the lessons in your scheme of work. Select the lesson you want and click on 'save changes' This will place the new lesson activity in the class lesson tool bar



The prepare screen provides you with detailed information about your lesson activity including detailed lessons plans

The assessment screen allows you to assess each child's performance and provides an example of the different assessment levels



The report screen will give you a detailed report on each child's progress that can be printed.

- ★ It is important that each child has a folder created on the school computer in which to save their work. The children need to be taught how to save their work into their folder. They may need to open a previously saved piece of work and edit their work in a following lesson.
