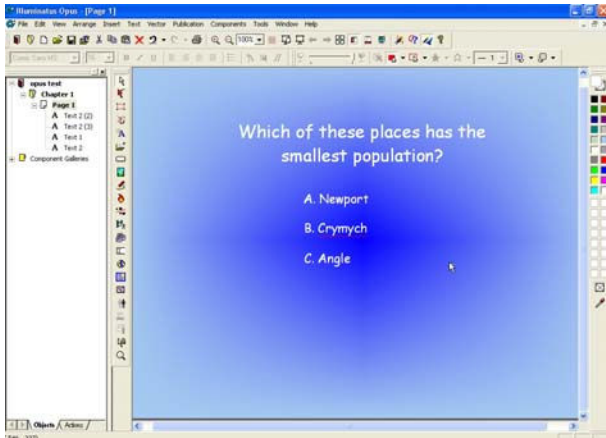
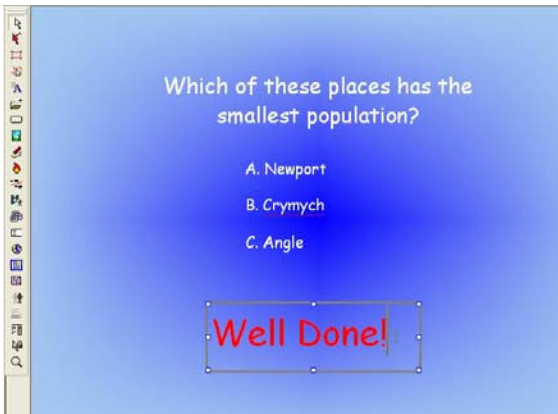


Make an Object Invisible, Then Appear in Illuminatus Opus

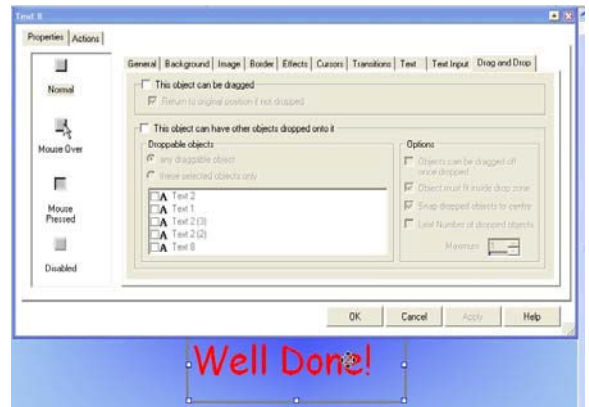

1. What I would like to do this time is make Opus display a Well Done message when the user clicks on the correct answer.

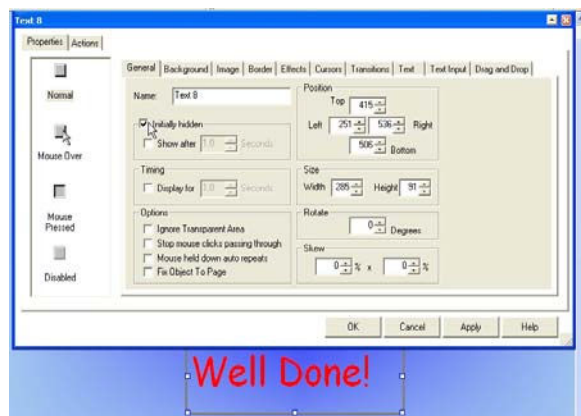
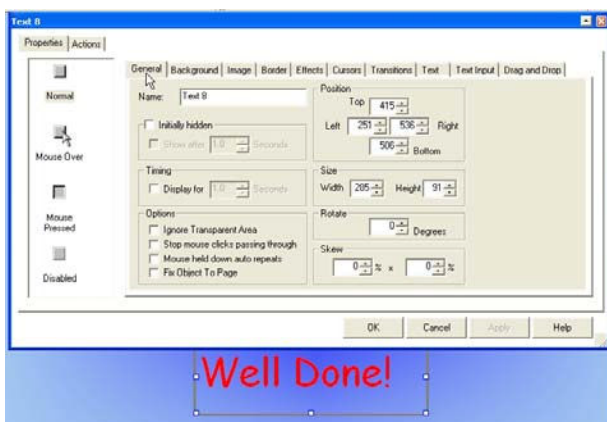


2. Click on the Text tool.



3. Click, hold and drag out a text box and type a 'well done' message in it.

4. Click twice on the Well Done text to open up its Properties box.

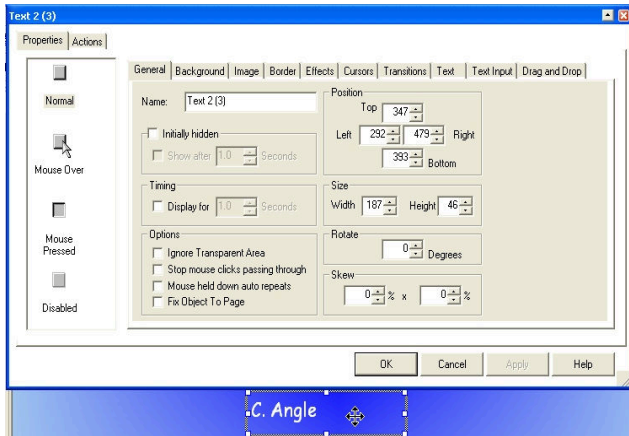


5. Click on the General tab.

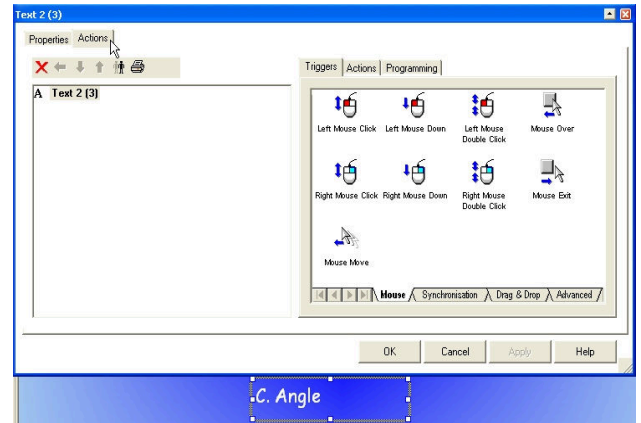
6. Click and tick the box labelled Initially Hidden. Click on Apply/OK. This will make the Well Done text invisible when the page loads.

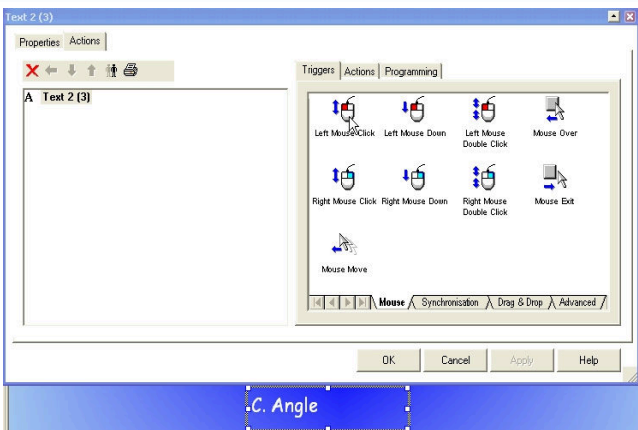

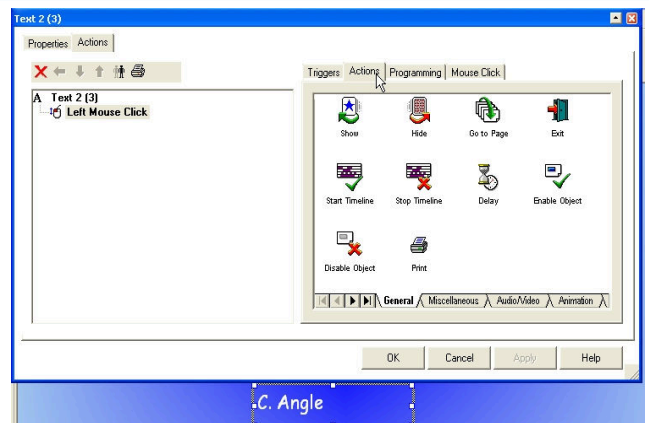
7. Click twice on the text box containing the correct answer to open up its properties box.



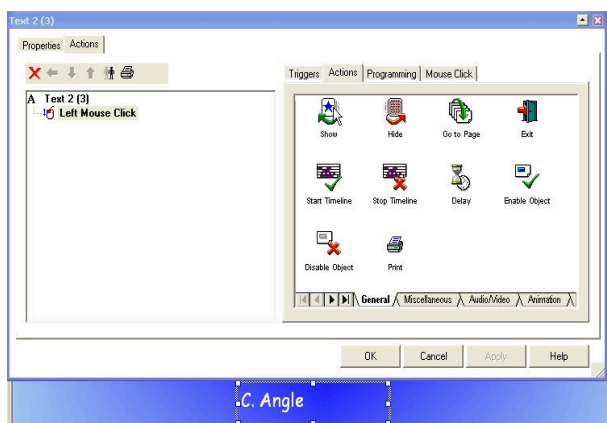
8. Click on the Actions tab.



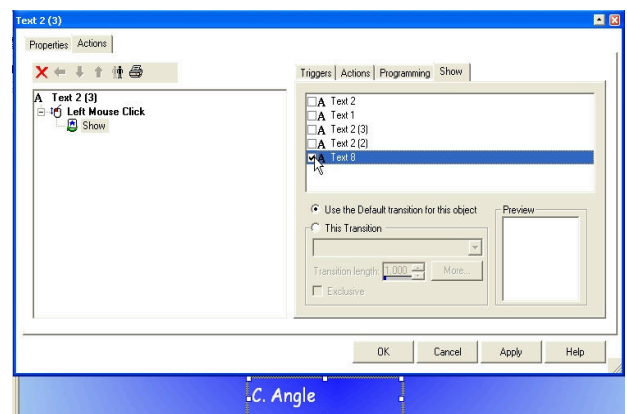
9. Click twice on Left Mouse Click.



10. Click on the Actions tab on the right.



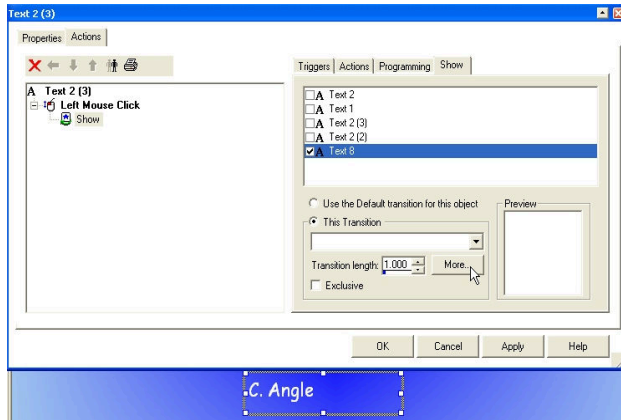
11. Click twice on Show.



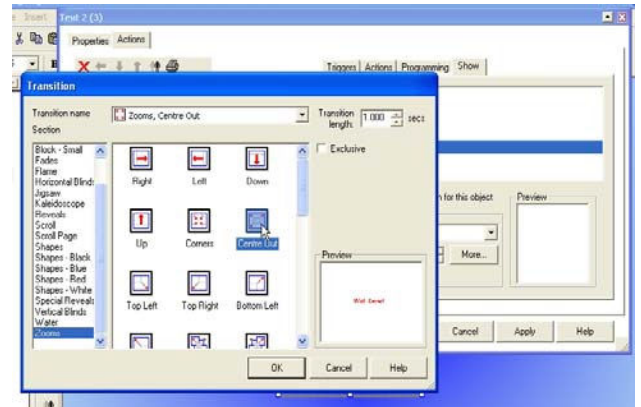
12. Click and tick the box of the object you want to show. In this case it is Text 8. Click Apply.

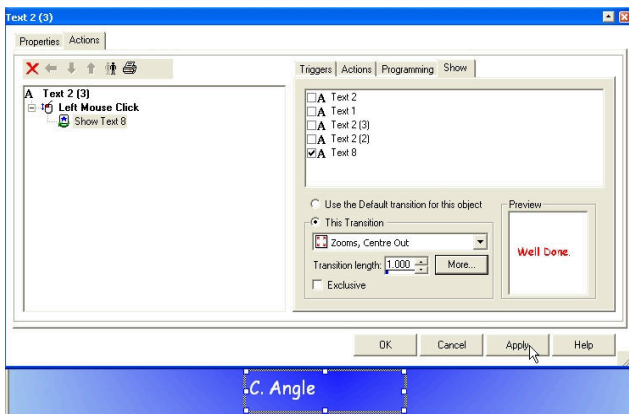

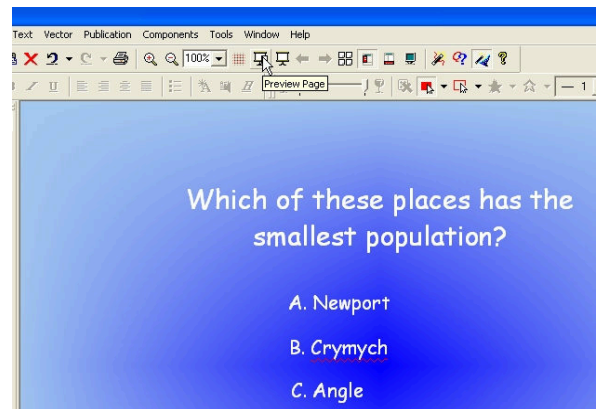
13. Let's make the text show with a transition. Click the circle next to This Transition and click More to choose a transition.



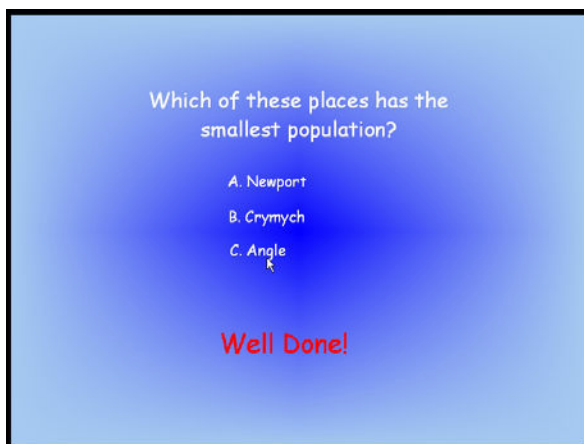
14. Choose a transition, make sure the Exclusive box is not ticked, and click on OK.

16. Preview your page by clicking on Preview at the top of the screen.
