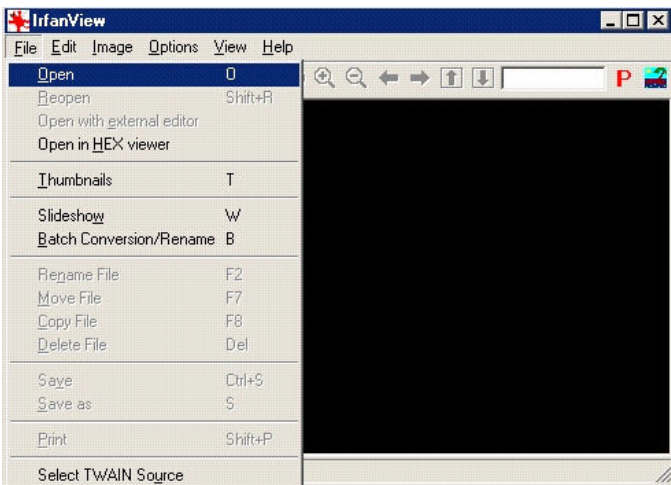
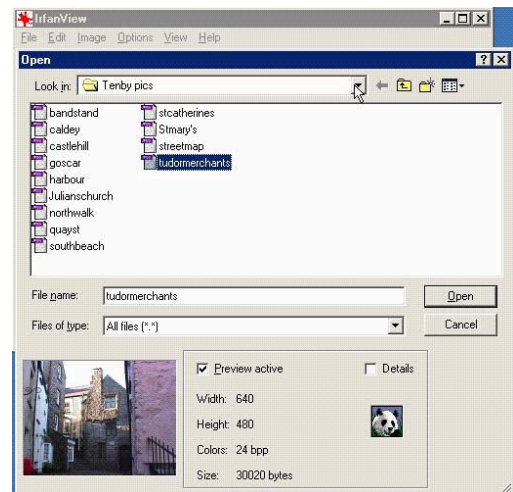


Useful Things To Do With Irfanview—Open, Crop and Save a Picture

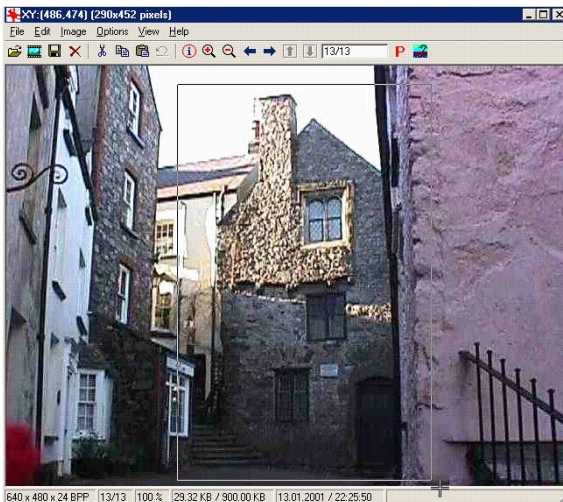

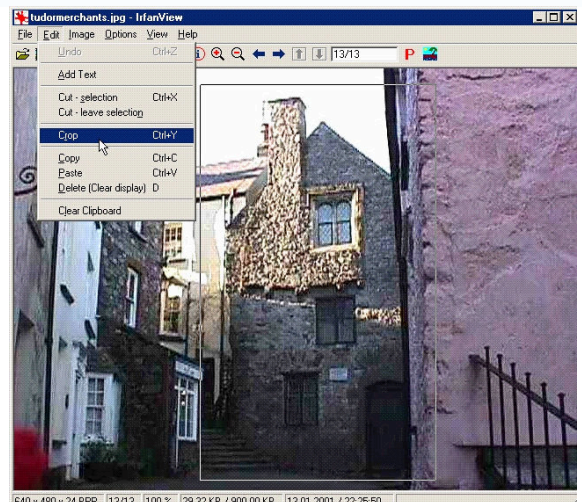
1. Sometimes you want to cut parts out of an image so that you can see one object better. To do this we need to 'crop' the image. Click on 'File' and 'Open' to get a picture.



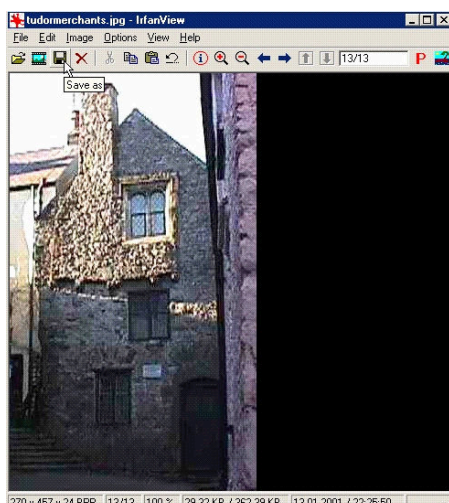
2. Click on the arrow pointing down at the end of the 'Look in' box and look for a folder where you have saved some pictures.



3. In this picture I want to see only the Tudor Merchant's House. Click with the left hand mouse button, hold it down and drag out a selection box around the part of the image you want.



4. Let go of the left hand button, then click on 'Edit' and 'Crop'.



5. Now you have cropped your image, go to save it by clicking on 'File' and 'Save as' or you can click on the floppy disc icon towards the top of the window.
