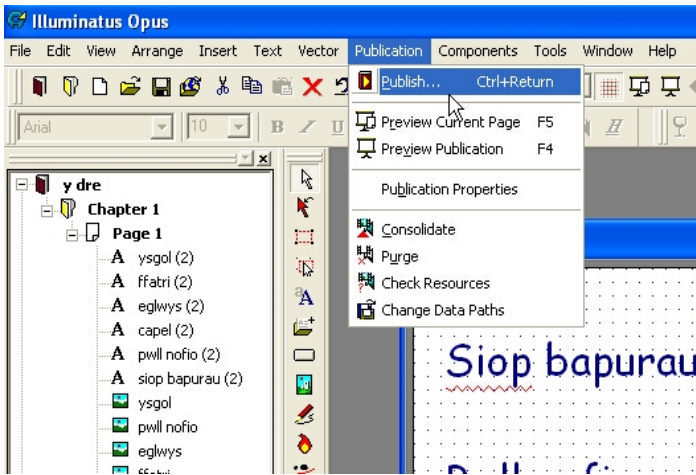
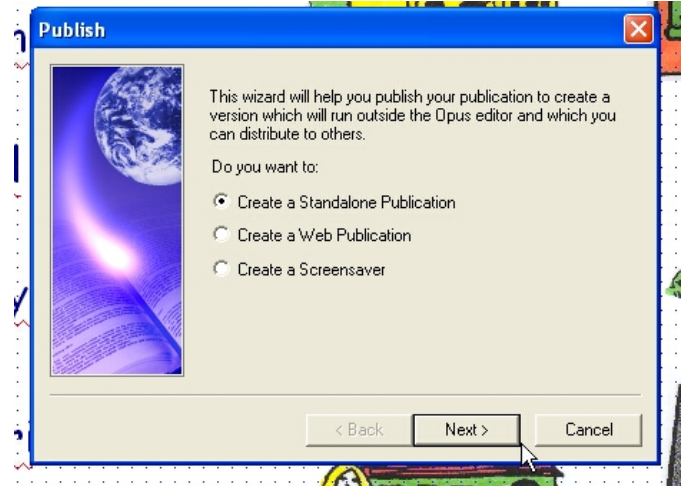


Publishing an Illuminatus Opus Presentation and Saving it to CD

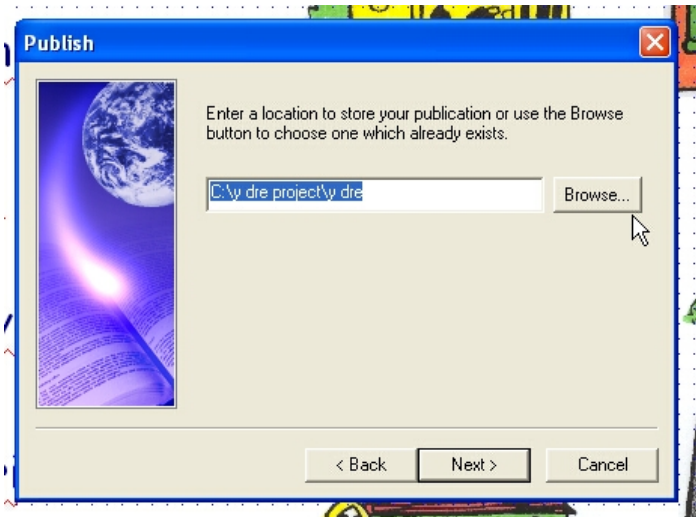

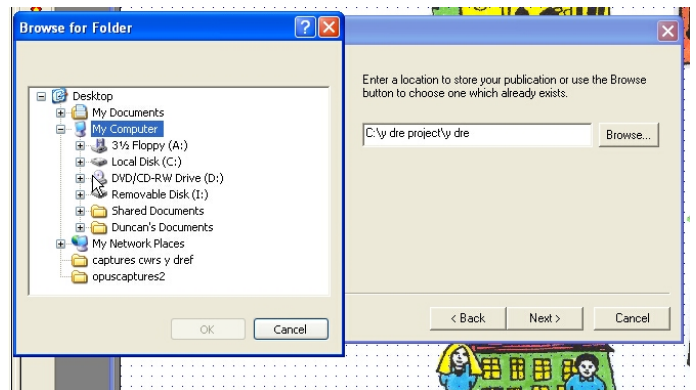
1. Before we start, make a folder on the C: drive to put your published presentation in. Click on 'Publication' at the top of the screen and click on 'Publish'.



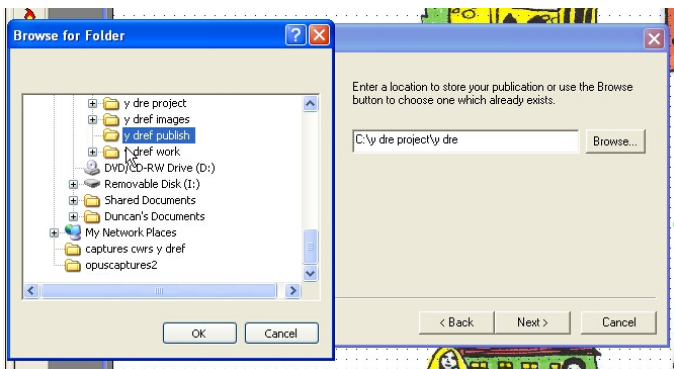
2. Choose 'Create a Standalone Publication' and click on 'Next'.



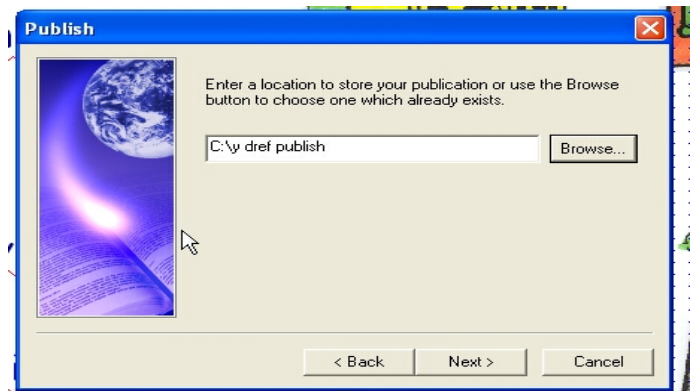
3. When it asks you to enter a location for your publication click on 'Browse'.



4. This opens up a map of your computer. Click on the + next to disk C:



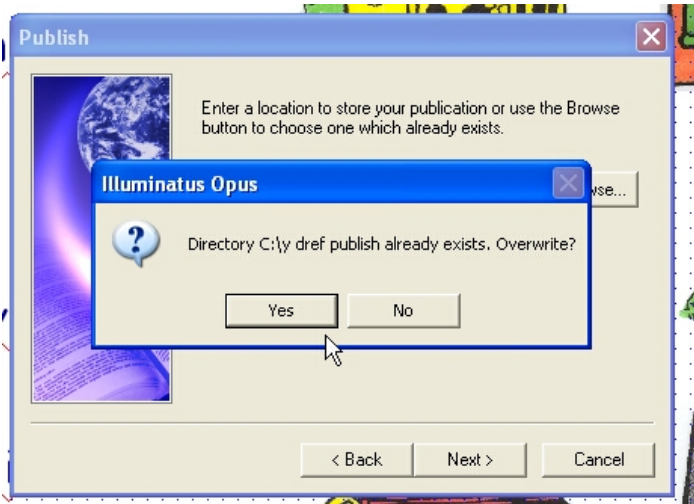
5. Click **once** on the folder you made, in this case it is called 'y dre publish' (it's good to put the name 'publish' in there) and click on OK.



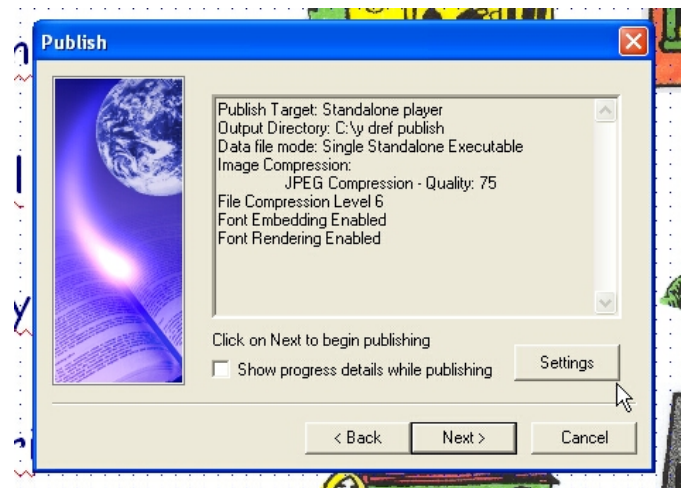
6. The name of your folder should now be in the box next to 'Browse'. Now click on 'Next'.

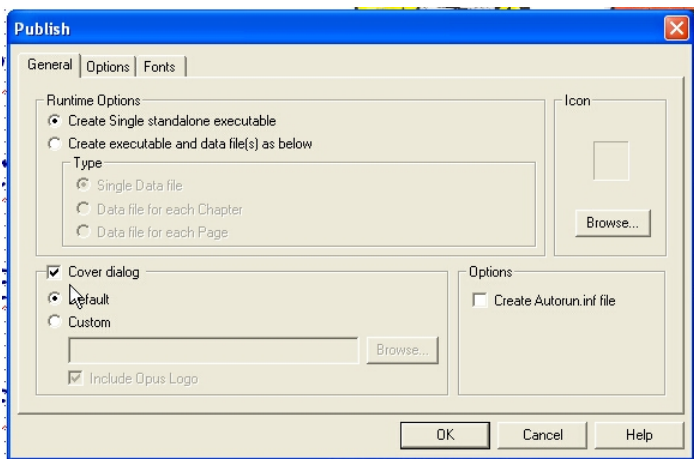

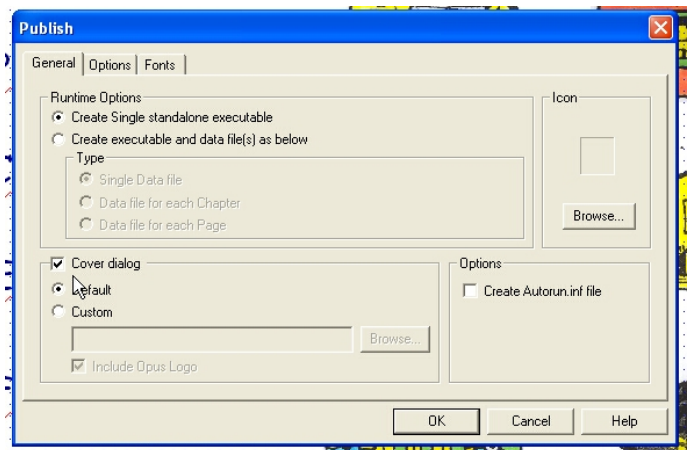
7. When this message appears click on 'Yes'.



8. Now click on 'Settings' to add some finishing touches to your publication.



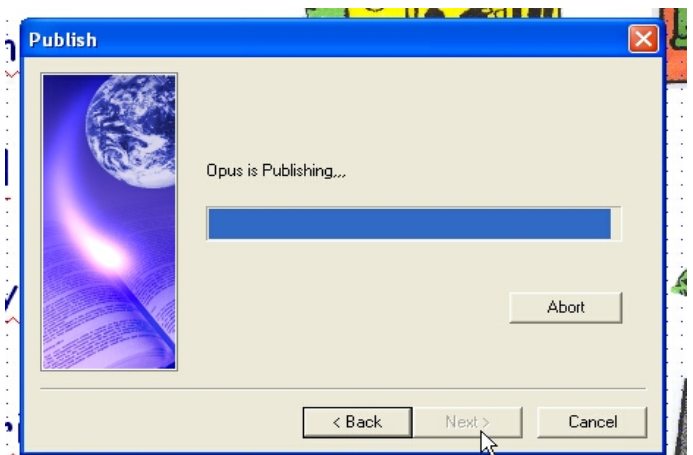
9. Click on the tick next to 'Cover dialog' so that the tick disappears.



10. In the Options box tick 'Create autorun .inf file' by clicking in the box. This will make your final CD start automatically.



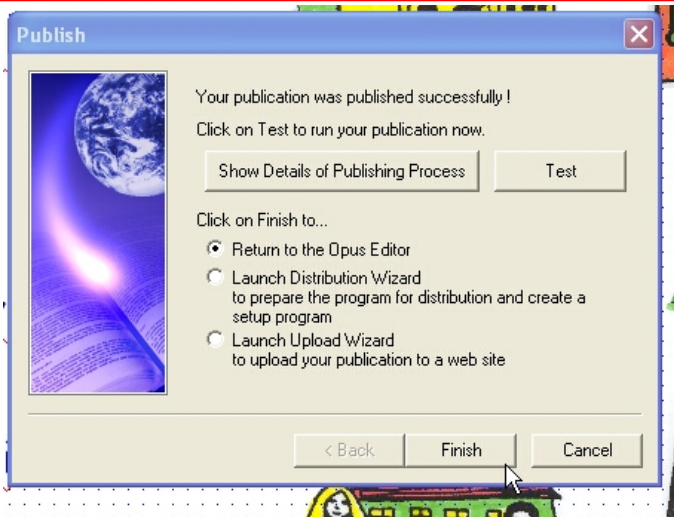
11. Now click on 'Next'.



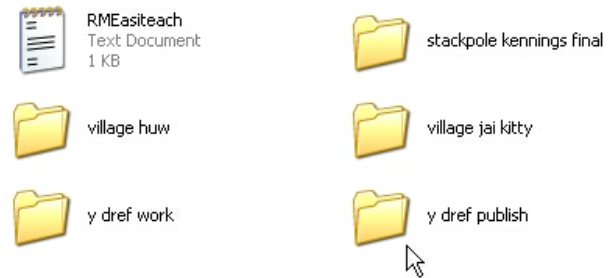
12. Opus starts to publish your presentation to the folder on your C: drive so that it can be played on any computer.

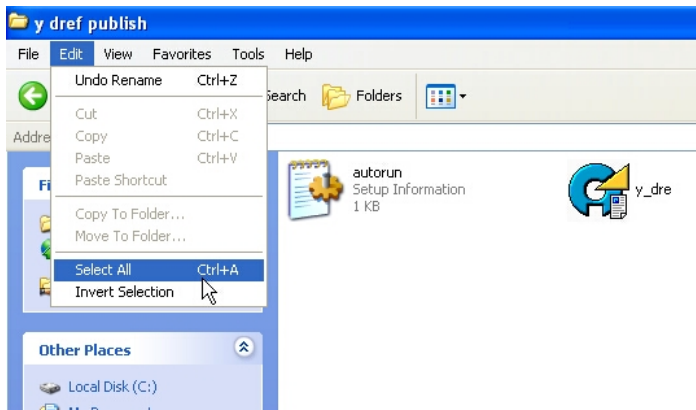

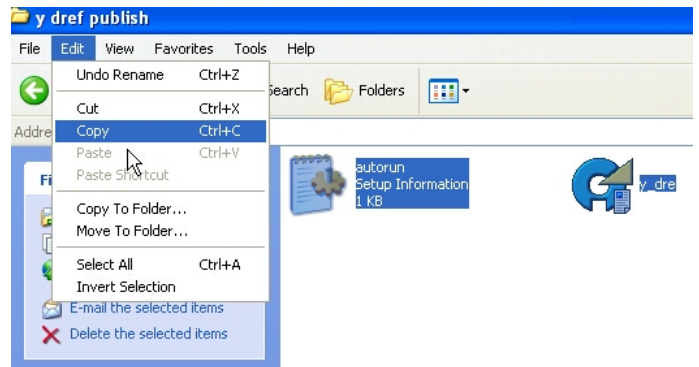
13. Click on 'Finish' and it's done. You can close Illuminatus Opus now.



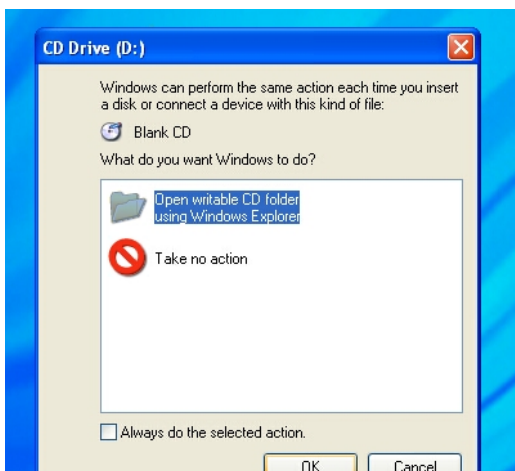
14. Now it's time to copy your presentation files to a CD. Open the folder you published to by clicking twice on it.



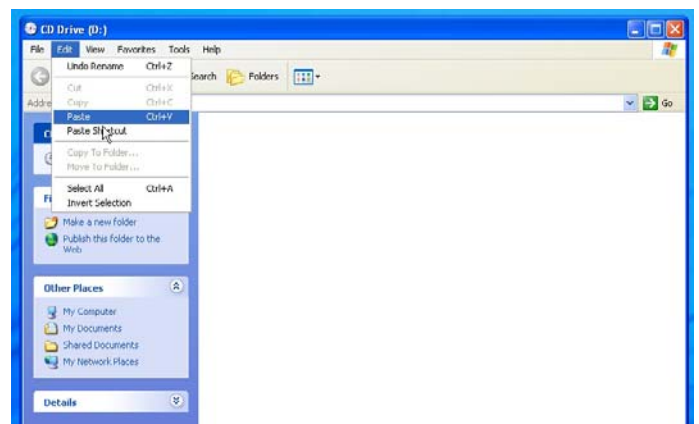
15. You'll see two files in the folder: an autorun file and your publication file. Click on 'Edit' an 'Select All'.



16. Now click on 'Edit' and 'Copy'.



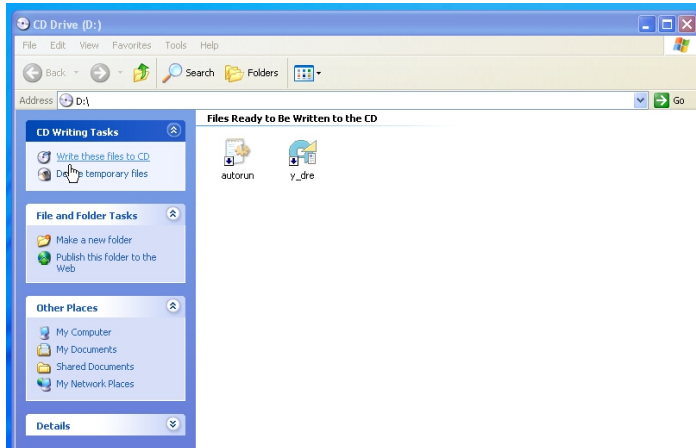
17. Put a blank recordable CD into the Cd drive of your computer. In Windows XP a window like this will open. Click on OK and it will show you the contents of your CD—it should be empty.



18. Click on 'Edit' and 'Paste'.

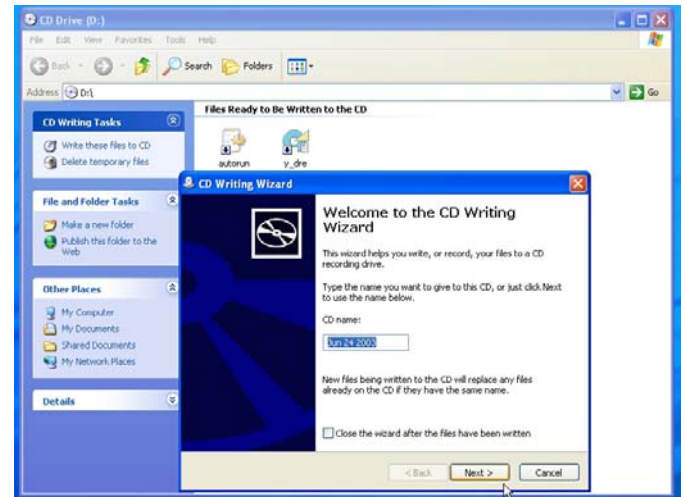

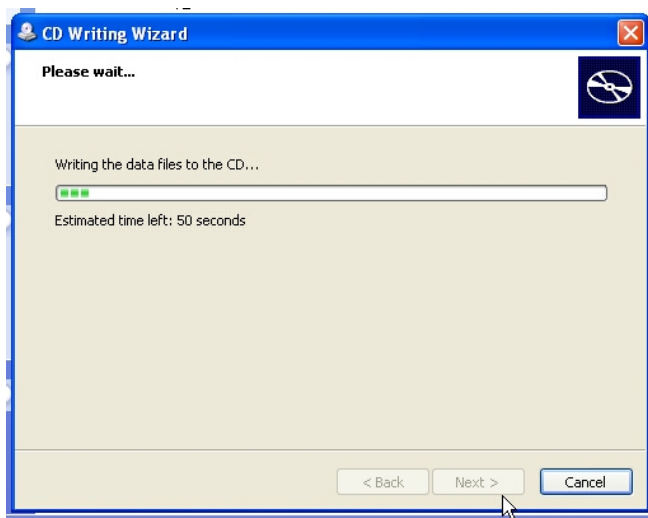


19. Your two files should appear in the window. Now click 'Write these files to CD'.

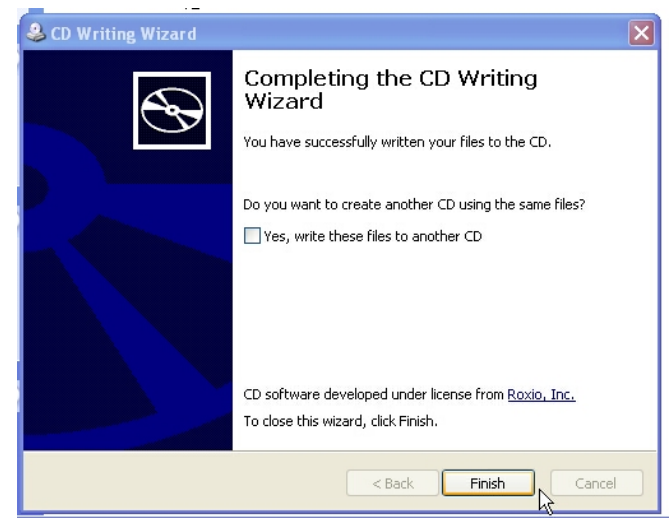
If your files do not paste in. Go back to the folder on your C: drive and copy the two files again. Then repeat step 18.



20. The CD writing wizard opens, click on 'Next'.



21. Your computer starts to save your work to the CD.



22. When it's finished the computer will eject the recorded CD and you can click on 'Finish' to stop the CD writing wizard.

Your CD is now ready to use and it should play on any computer. The user's computer does not have to have Opus on it for them to look at your presentation. Your CD will start automatically in a very professional way.
