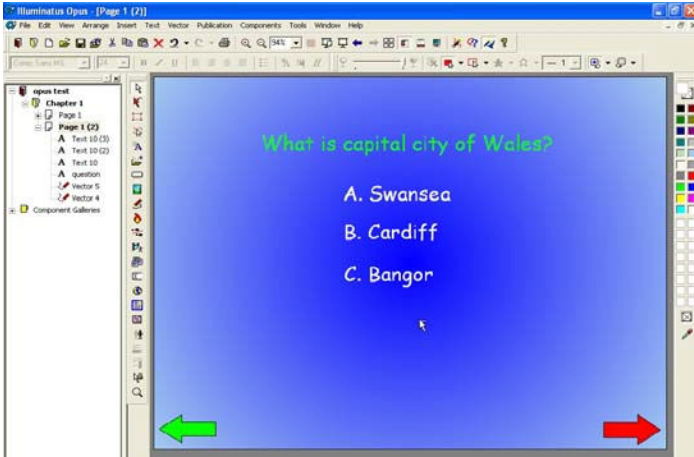
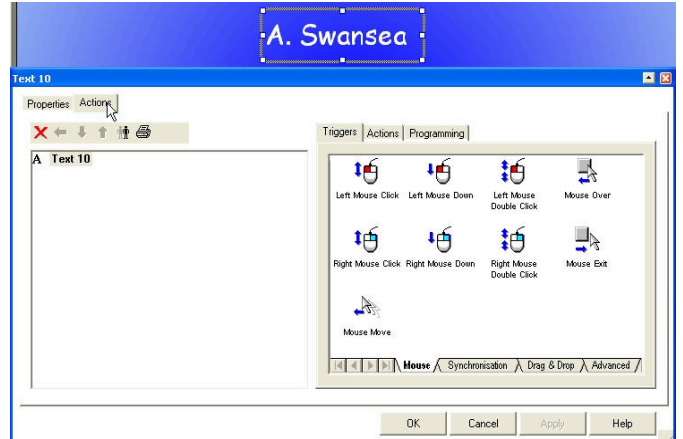

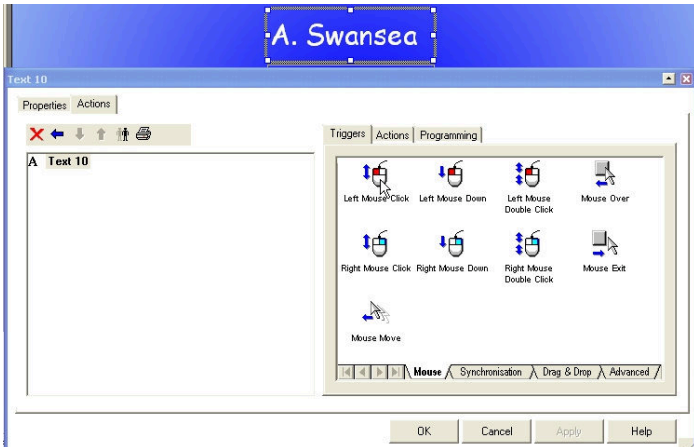

1. Let's make a simple multiple choice quiz where sound effects tell you if you are right or wrong. Start by making a page with a question and three answers.



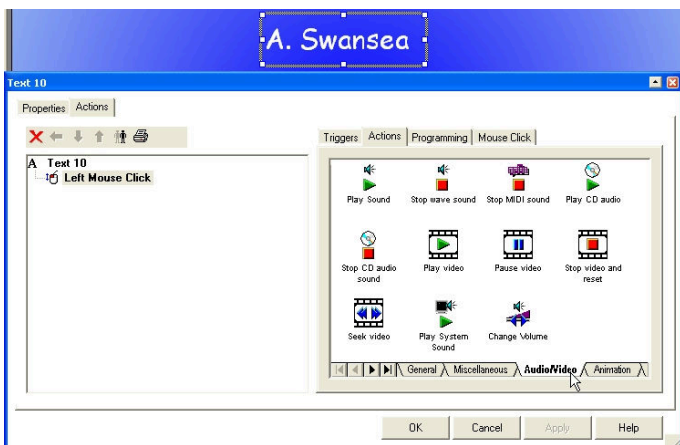
2. Click twice on one of the answers to open its Properties box. Click on the Actions tab. Click on the Triggers tab on the right-hand side.



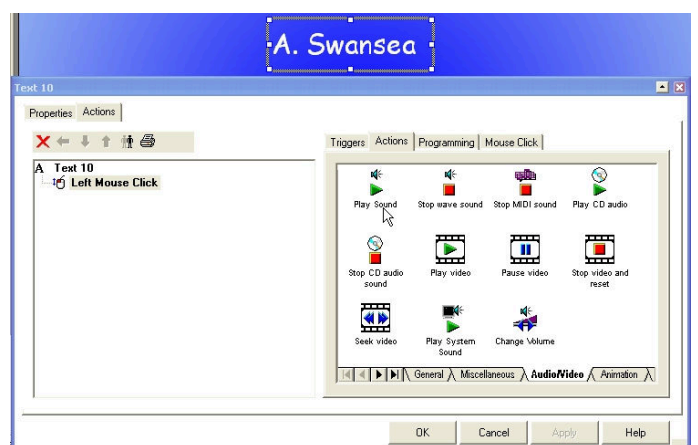
3. Click twice on Left Mouse Click.



4. Click on the Actions tab on the right-hand side.



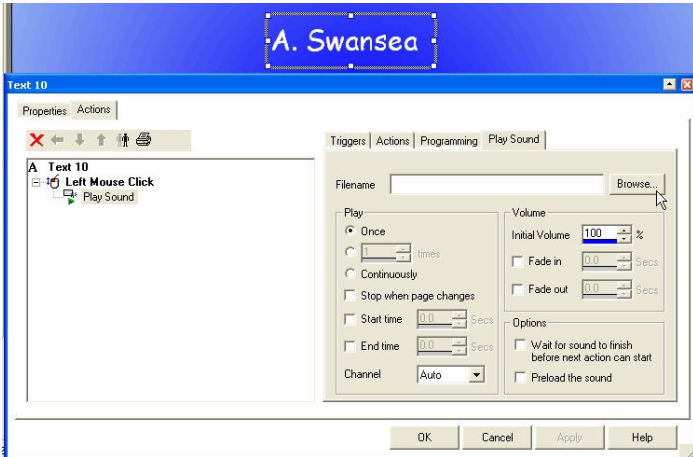
5. Click on the Audio/Video tab.



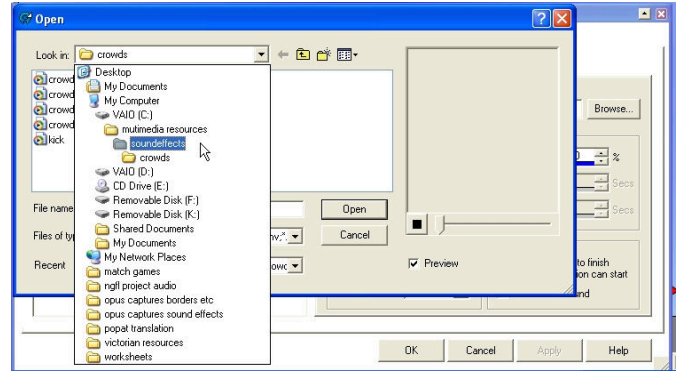
6. Click twice on Play Sound.

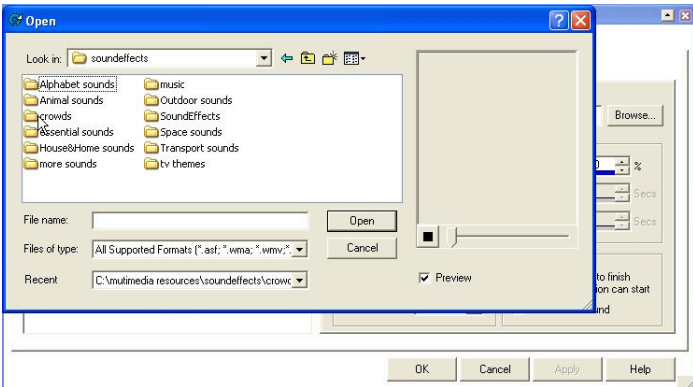

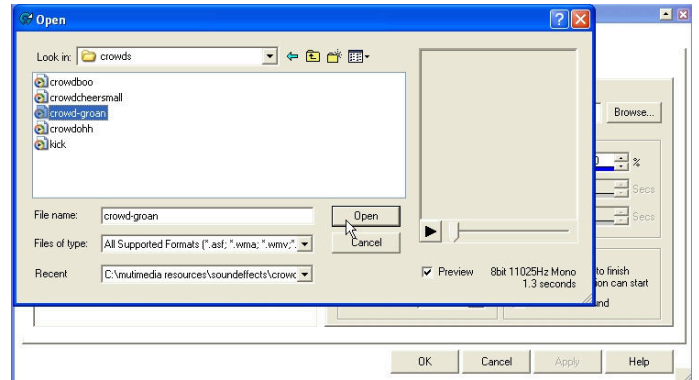
7. Click on Browse to look for a sound effect on your computer.



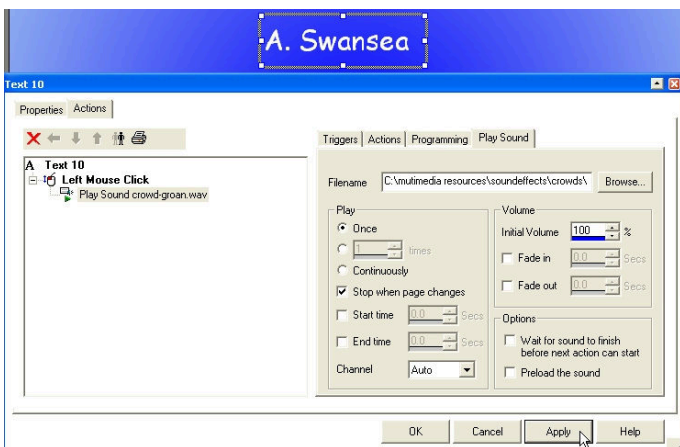
8. A directory, or map, of your computer opens up showing all of the places on your computer where things are stored. Find your sound effects folder. A CD with a folder of sound effects is supplied with this course. You can copy the folder onto your computer.



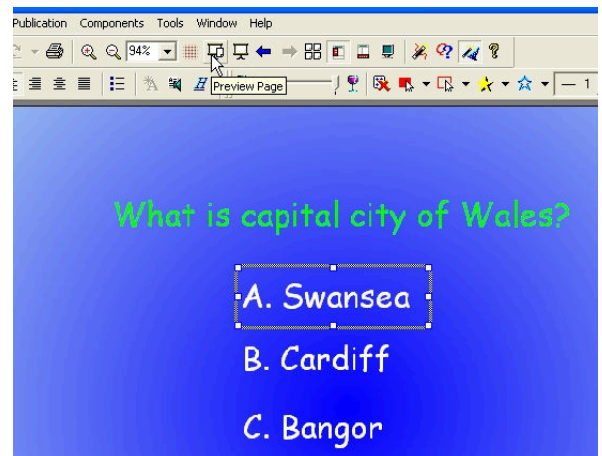
9. Click twice on the sound effects folder to open it. Click twice on the folder 'crowds'.



10. Click on a sound effect and click on Open. I have chosen 'crowd groan' for a wrong answer.



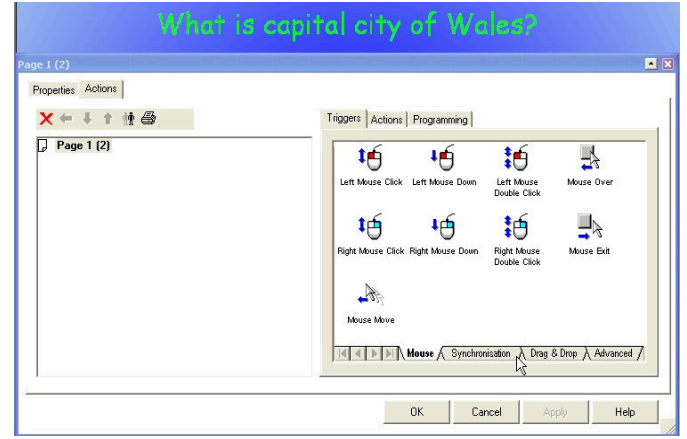
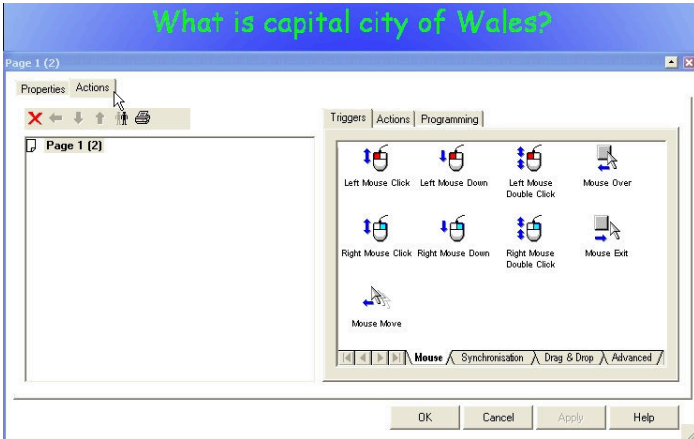
11. In the control box for the sound effect tick the box 'Stop when page changes' and click Apply.



12. Click on preview to see the page in action. Hopefully, when you click on the word the sound effect will play. Repeat this process for the other two answers.

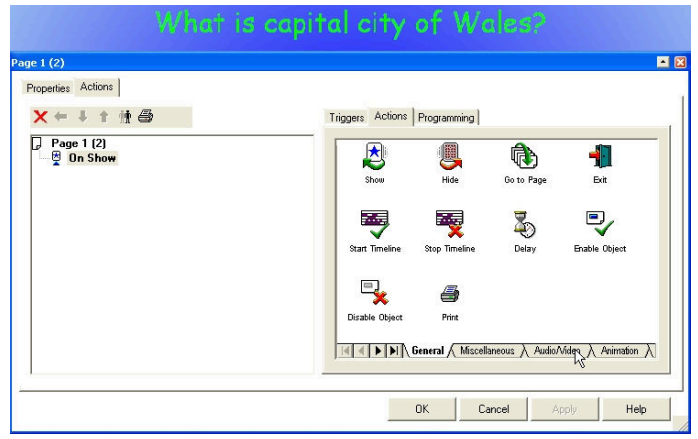
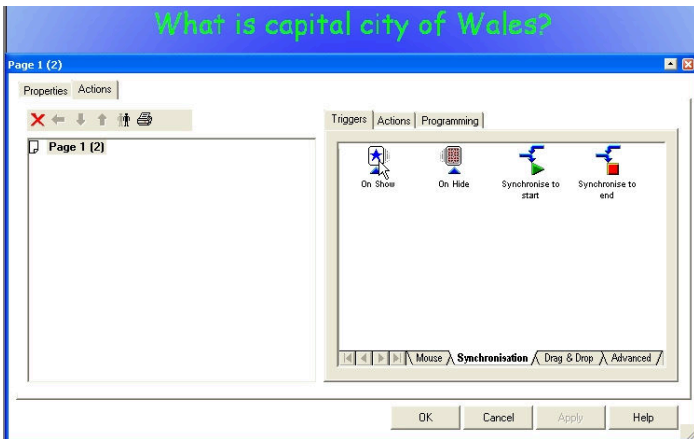

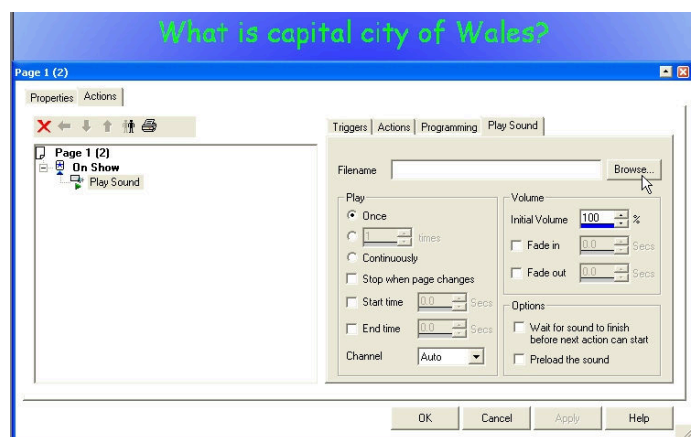
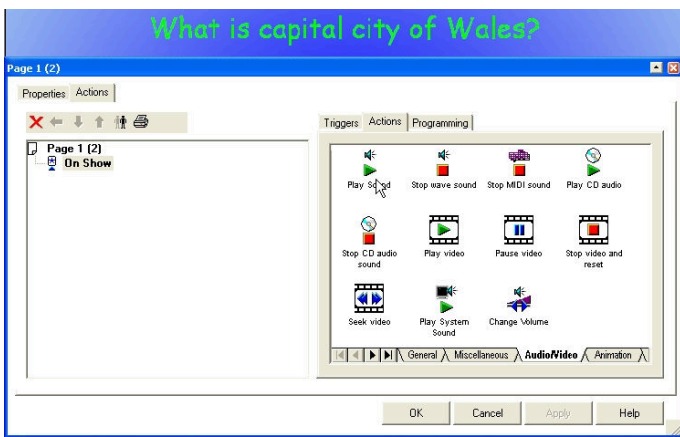
13. To make a sound effect play automatically when a page loads, start by clicking twice on the page to open its Properties box and click on the Actions tab.

14. Under the Triggers tab on the right, click the Synchronisation tab.



15. Click twice on On Show.

16. Click on the Actions tab on the right and click on the Audio/Video tab.

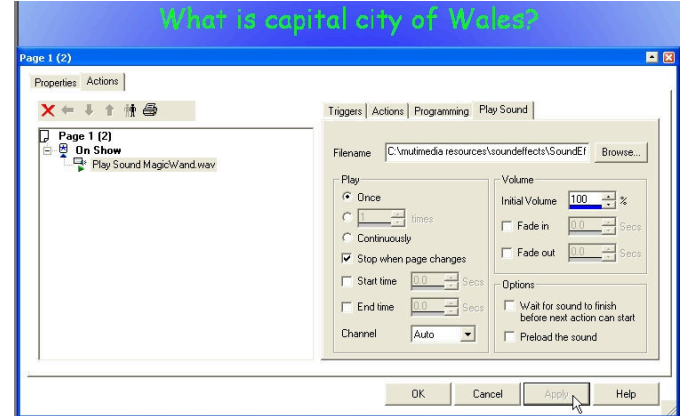
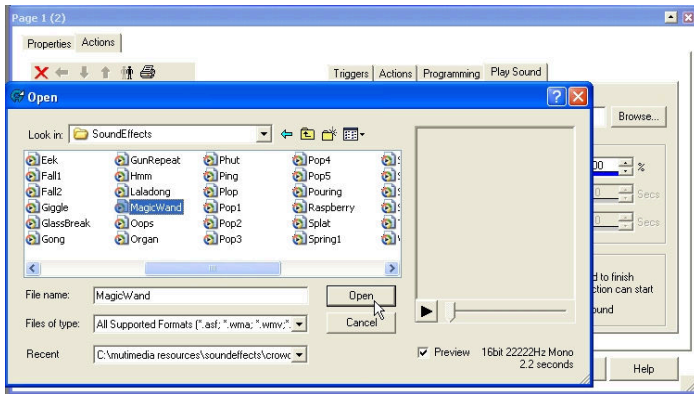


17. Click twice on Play Sound.

18. Click on browse to look for a sound effect on your computer.

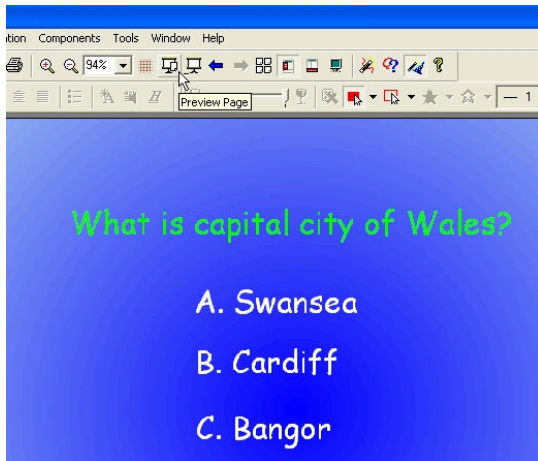

19. Look in your sound effects folder. I've chosen a sound called 'Magic Wand'. Click on Open.

20. In the sound effect control box click and tick the box Stop When Page Changes and click on Apply. Now when the page shows it will play the sound Magic Wand.



21. Click on Preview at the top of the page to test the page and hear the sound.
