

Gwyliau – Year 6

Software - Resources

Powerpoint was used for this presentation. Welsh phrase/vocabulary flash cards were useful for spellings.

Context

The activity lent itself to the ICT and Welsh work being undertaken that term. The children had already used ClipArt in other IT work so had a good idea on what was available and how to search for suitable pictures.

Organisation

It was the children's first experience of using Powerpoint so the activity was carried out as a class with decisions being made collaboratively and everyone taking it in turns to work at the computer.

Activity

The children were introduced to the program Powerpoint and they then planned the content of their pages based on a central character and his holidays. They used the language patterns they had been learning in Welsh lessons and asked and answered questions relating to the character in the story. The children worked in small groups at the computer on a page at a time, typing in the text and inserting ClipArt pictures to add interest.

Conclusion – Extension work

Dialogue to be added next time this task is undertaken so that the children are also practising spoken Welsh.

Curriculum links
