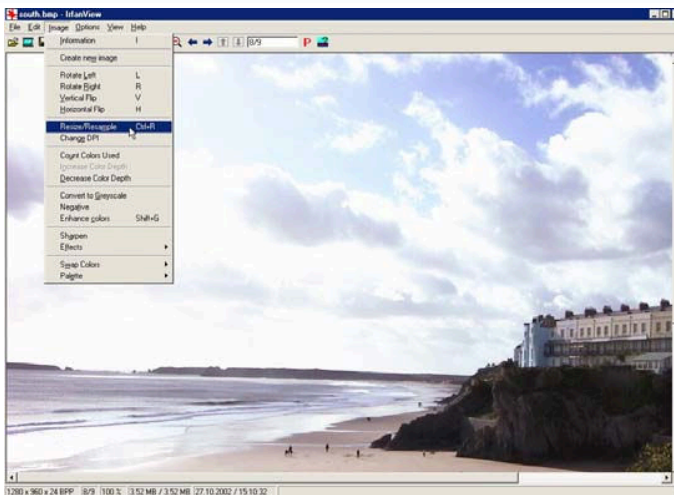
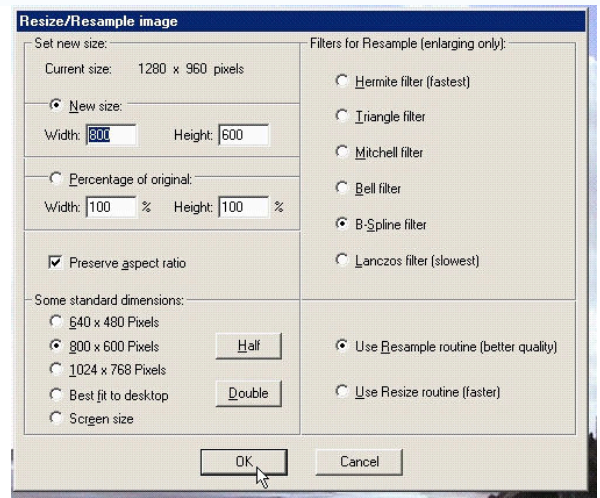


Useful Things To Do With Irfanview—Make a Background Image

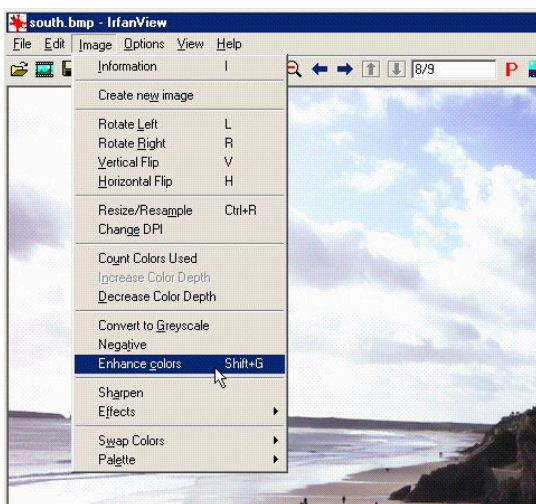

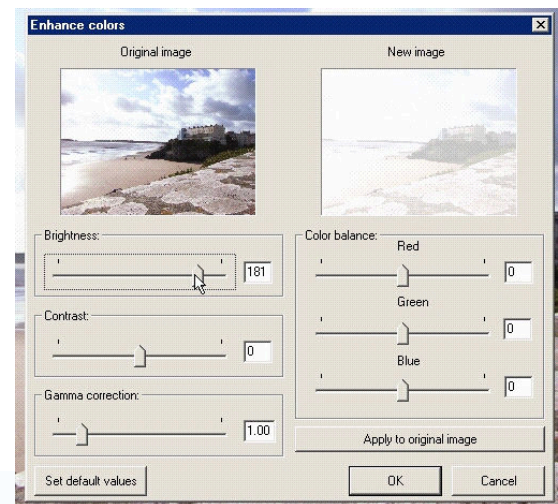
1. I want to turn this picture into an image that is suitable as a background for my whiteboard or for a presentation. It needs to be light so that writing is clearly seen on the top of it. First, re-size the image: click on 'Image', 'Resize/Resample'.



2. Click on 800 x 600 Pixels in the Resize/Resample window, then click on OK. This size will fill the screen on most web pages, whiteboards and presentations.

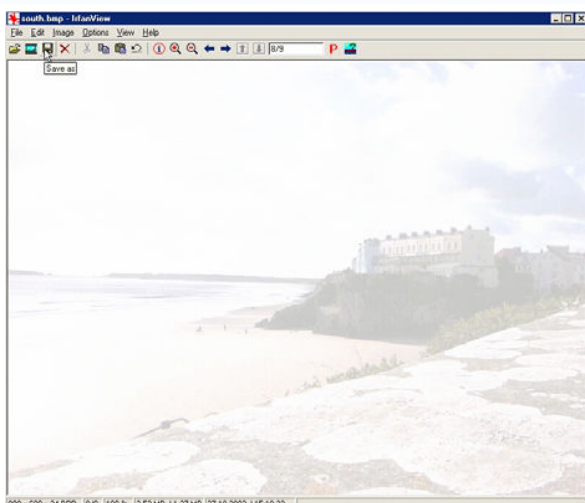


3. Now click on 'Image' and 'Enhance Colours'.



4.

Lighten the image by increasing the brightness. That's all



5. Now you have the perfect background image. Click on 'File' and 'Save As', save it as a JPEG and go to 'Options' and compress the image by approximately 50%.

Quality isn't so important here, the smaller the file size, the less it will slow down presentations on the whiteboard.
