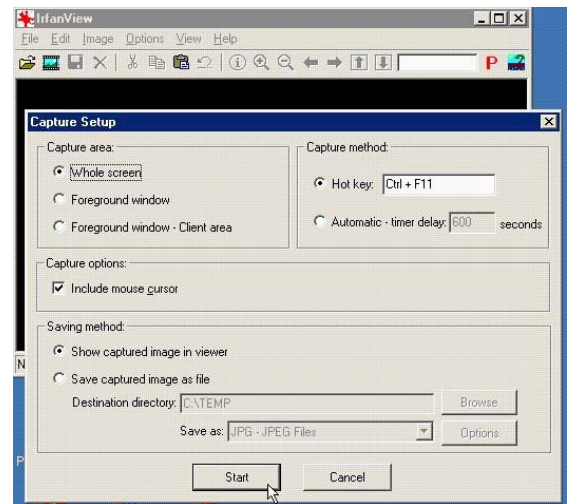
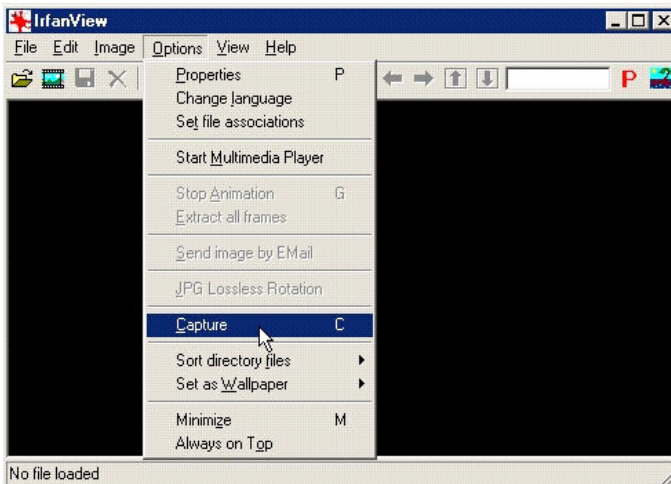


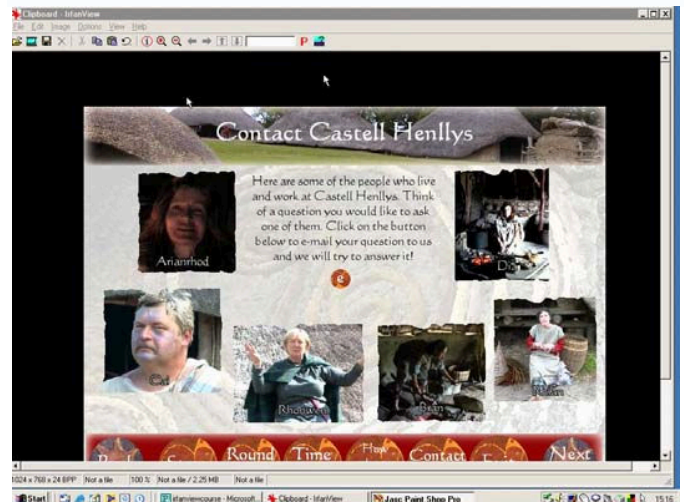
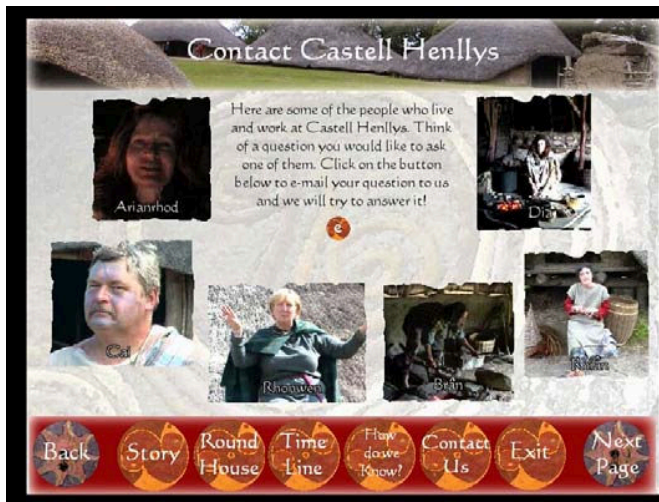
Useful Things To Do With Irfanview—Capture an Image From the Screen

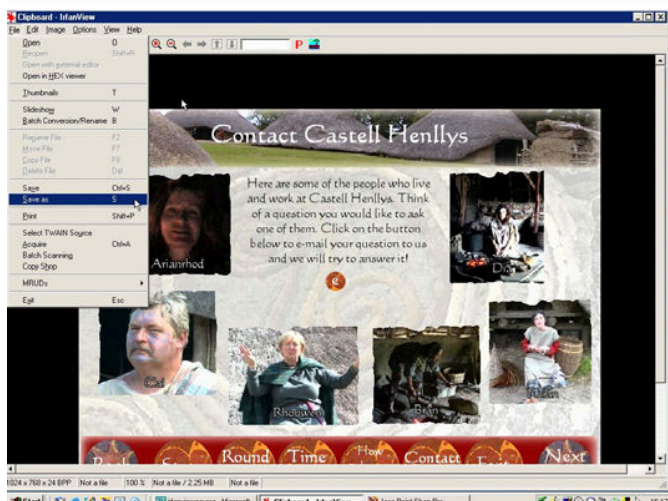
1. If you want to get a picture from a CD, Word document, Powerpoint presentation etc. you can get by using a Screen Capture. To do this click on 'Options' and 'Capture'.

2. The Capture window opens, choose to capture the 'whole screen' then click on 'Start'



3. Irfanview disappears, then you can run your CD or open whatever document you want to capture (as above). To capture what you see as an image press the Ctrl and F11 keys

4. Irfanview pops up with your screen appearing as an image. You can now edit and crop this image—do anything you like with it!



5. Now go to save it by clicking on 'File' and 'Save as' or you can click on the floppy disc icon towards the top of the window.

This feature is fantastic and easy to use. I used it to get the pictures for these training notes. It has many useful for producing teaching resources.
