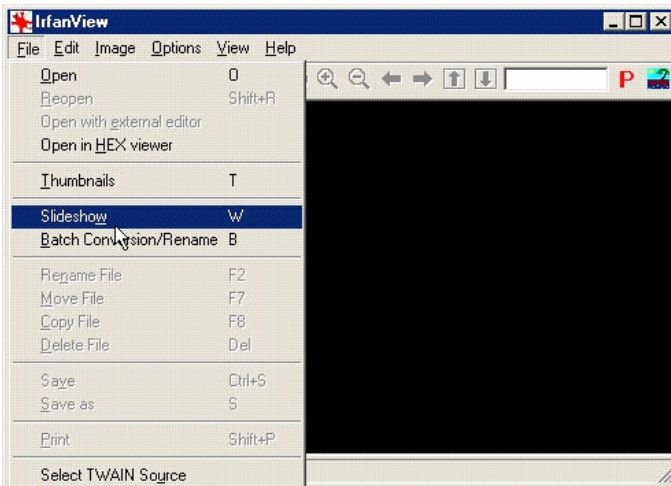
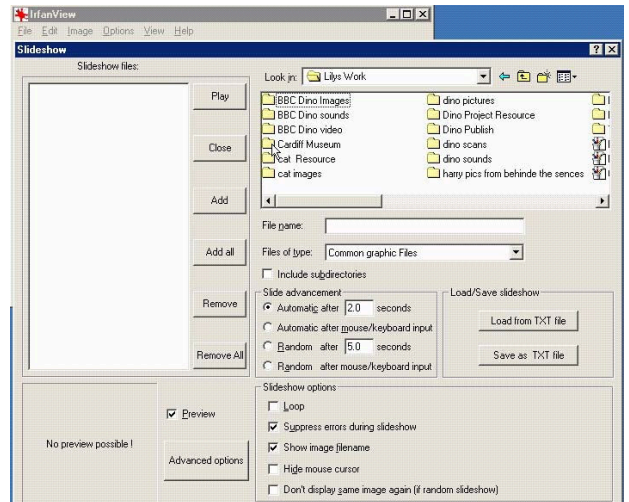


# Useful Things To Do With Irfanview—Make a Slideshow

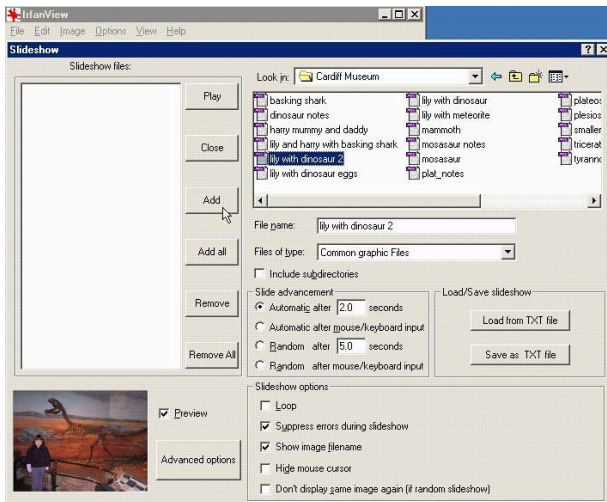

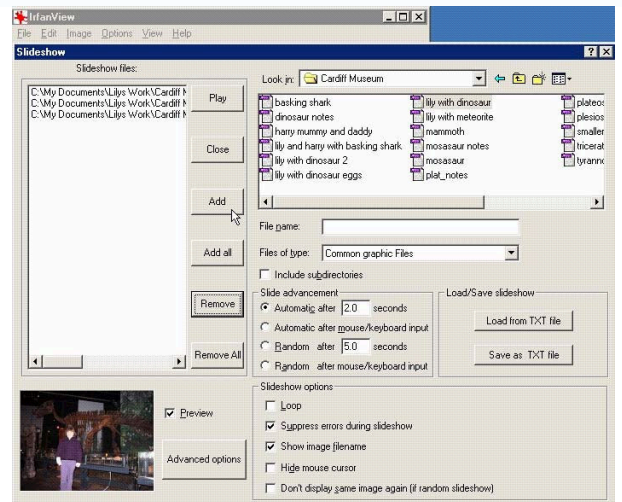
1. If you have a collection of images from a school trip or of children's work you can show them on the whiteboard as a slideshow. Click on 'File' and 'Slideshow'.



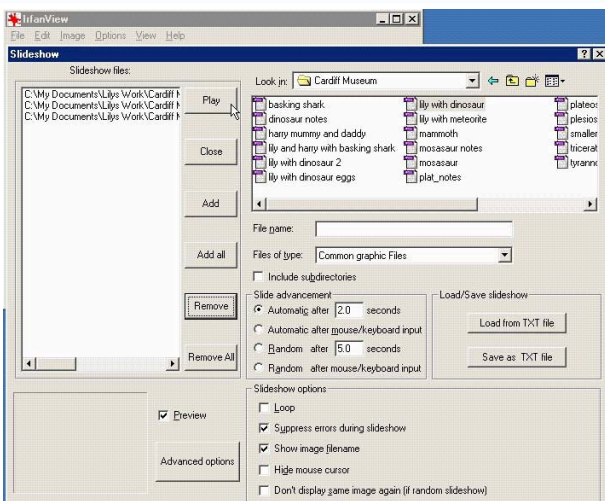
2. The Slideshow window opens. Click twice on a folder that has your pictures in it, I've chosen to open the folder 'Cardiff'.



3. You then see all of the images in the folder, click on one and a thumbnail of that image appears, click on 'Add' and the file will appear in the left side of the window where it says 'Slideshow Files'.



4. Add some more pictures. You could click on the 'Add All' button and add the lot—but I won't. You can also choose how long each slide shows for and you can loop the slideshow so it plays continuously.



5. When you've finished adding images to your slideshow click on the 'Play' button. Your slideshow will play full screen on the whiteboard—it's a great way to look at pictures.

To stop the slideshow at any time simply press the Esc key on your computer's keyboard.
