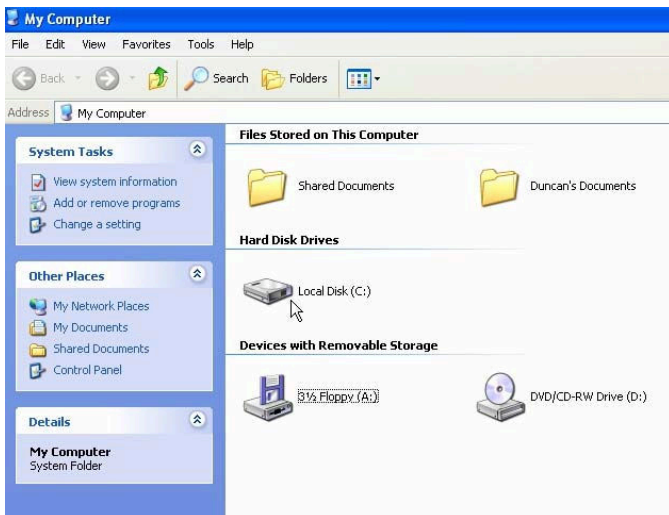
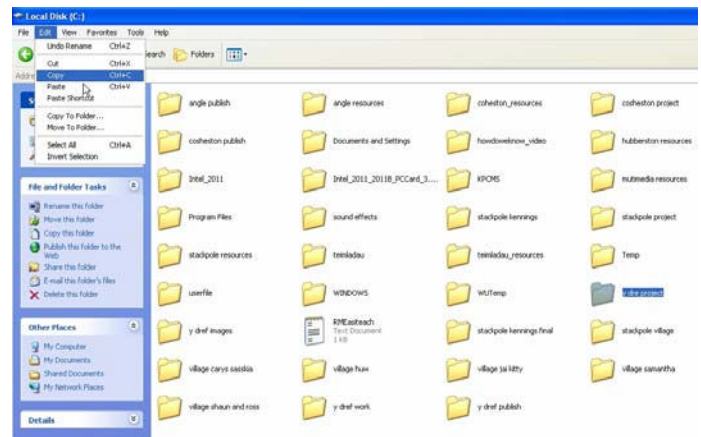


# Moving an Illuminatus Opus Publication From One Computer To Another

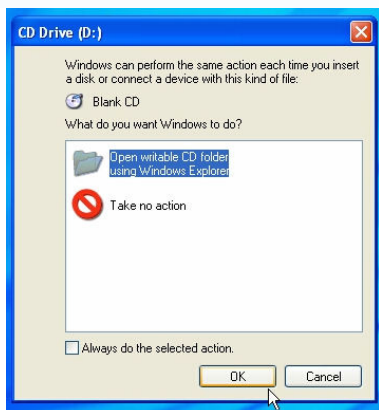

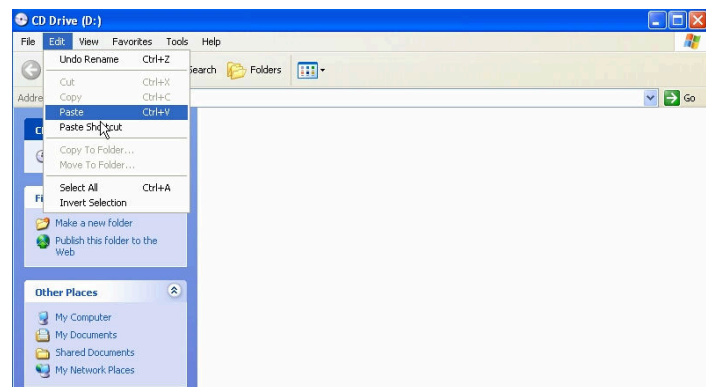
1. This is how to move your Opus publication from one computer to another, which may be necessary from time to time. To do this you will need a CD Writer on the computer system you are working on.



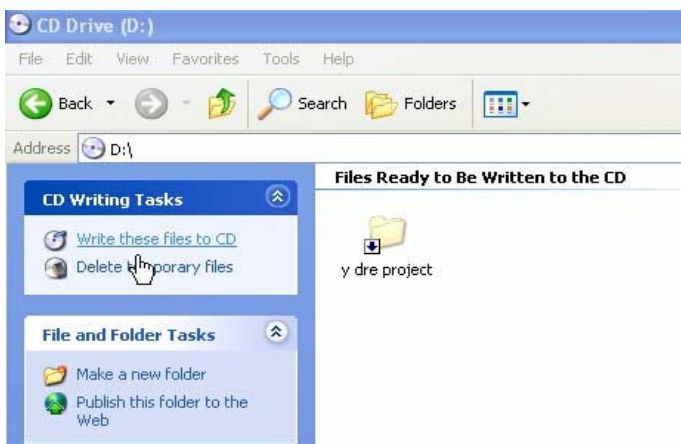
2. A window opens showing all of the folders on Disc C. Find the folder containing your publication. Click on it **once** then click on 'edit' and 'copy'.



3. Put a blank recordable CD into the CD drive of your Computer. In Windows XP a window automatically opens that asks you if you want to open a 'writable CD folder'. Click 'OK'.



4. A new window opens showing the contents of the CD you've just put in—there's nothing there. Click on 'edit' and 'paste'.



5. The folder with your publication in that you copied earlier is dropped into the CD folder.

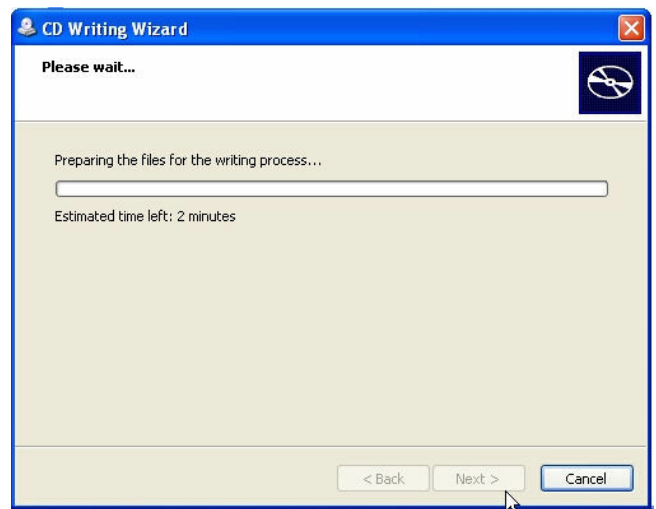
If this does not happen for any reason—don't panic. Minimise the CD Window and go back to the C: drive of your computer and copy the folder again as before. Then go back to the CD Window and click on 'edit' and 'paste' and it should drop in.

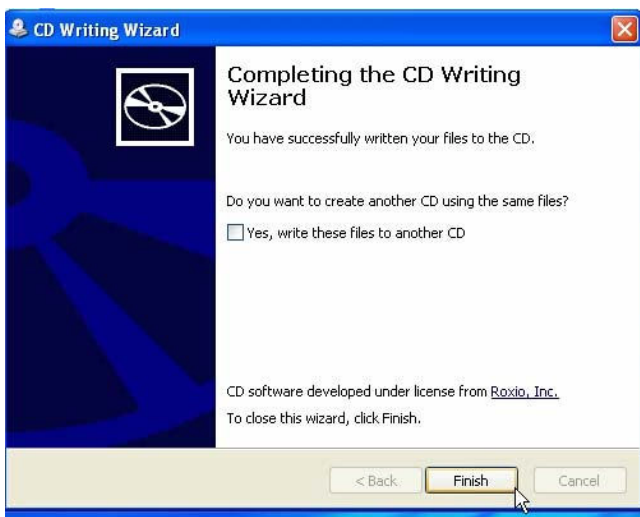

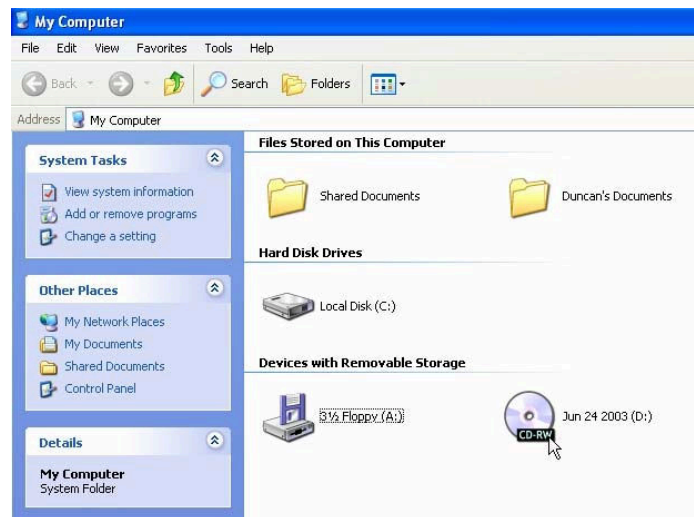
6. When the wizard opens you can name the CD if you wish, we won't, simply click 'Next'.



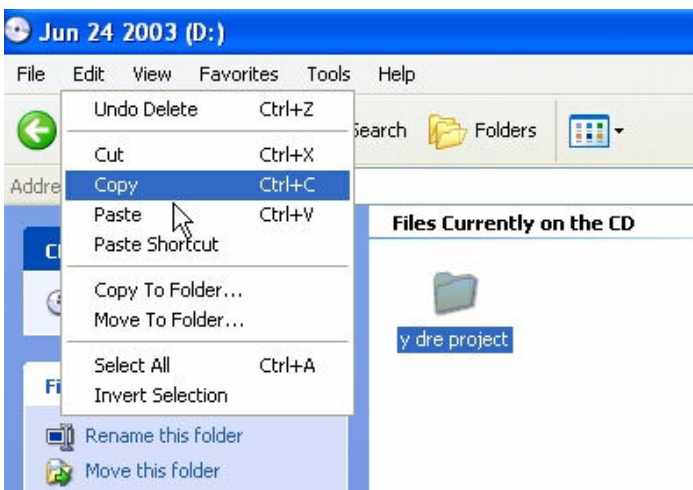
7. The computer starts to copy your work onto the CD.



8. When it has finished the computer will eject your finished CD and you can click on 'Finish'.



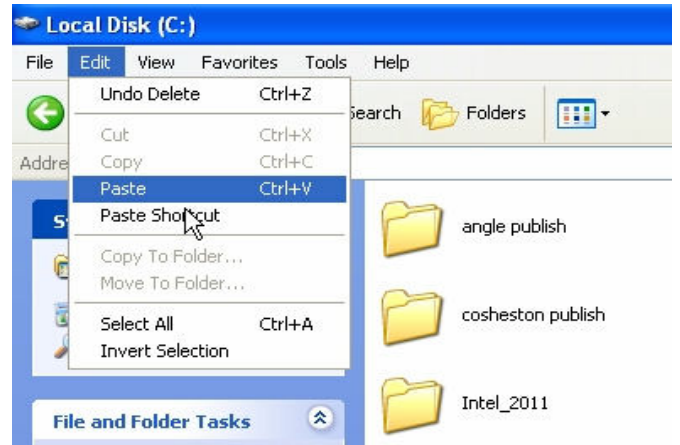
9. Now put your CD into a different computer, click on 'My Computer' then click on the CD drive of that computer.



10. A window opens showing the contents of your CD. Click **once** on the folder containing your publication and click on 'edit' and 'copy'. Now close the CD window.

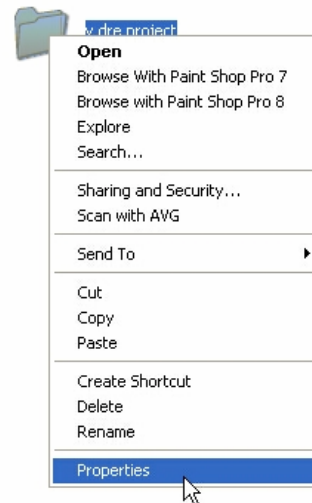
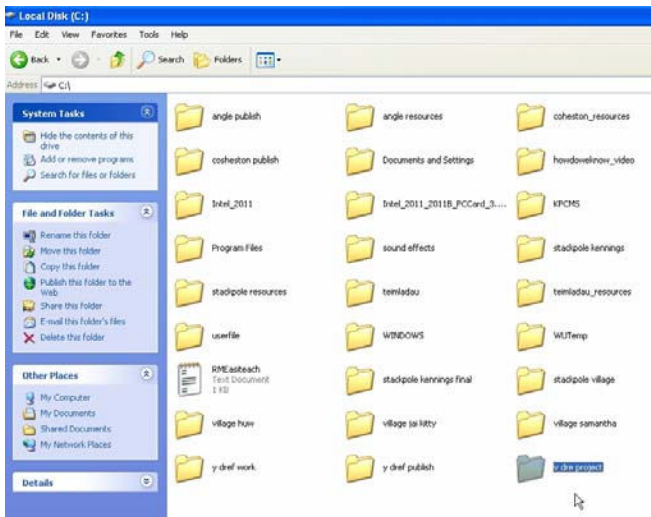

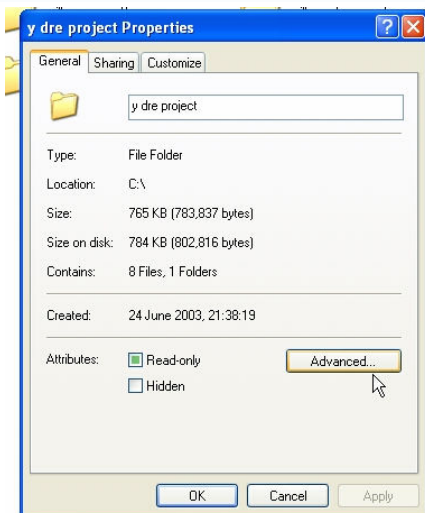
11. Click on 'My Computer', then click on Disk C:

12. A window opens showing the contents of Disk C: click on 'edit' and 'paste'.



13. The folder is dropped onto the C: drive of your computer.

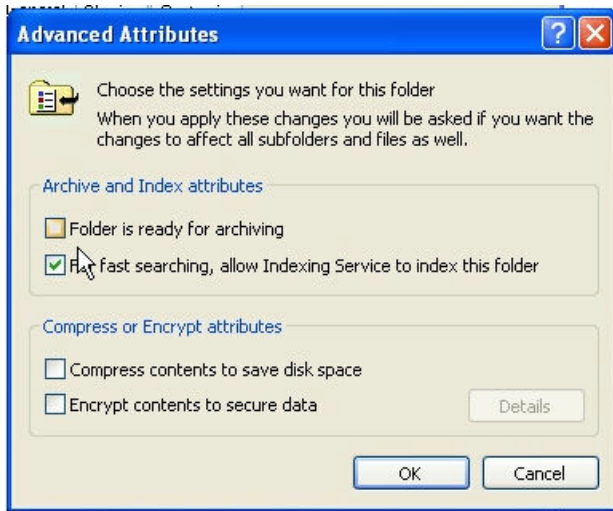
14. Now you need to do something to the folder you have copied. Whenever a folder is copied from a CD to another computer it arrives as something called a 'read only file'. That means you can look at it but you can't save to it. We need to change that.



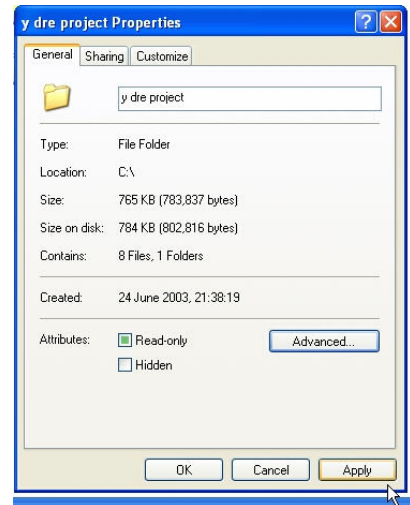
15. Click on 'Advanced' in the menu that opens.

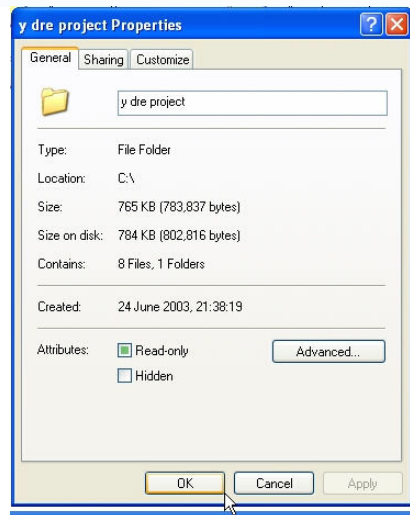
16. Click on 'folder is ready for archiving' (that means 'make it ready for saving to').



17. Click on 'Apply'.



18. Make sure 'Apply changes to this folder, subfolders and files' is checked, then click on OK.



19. Click on OK again.

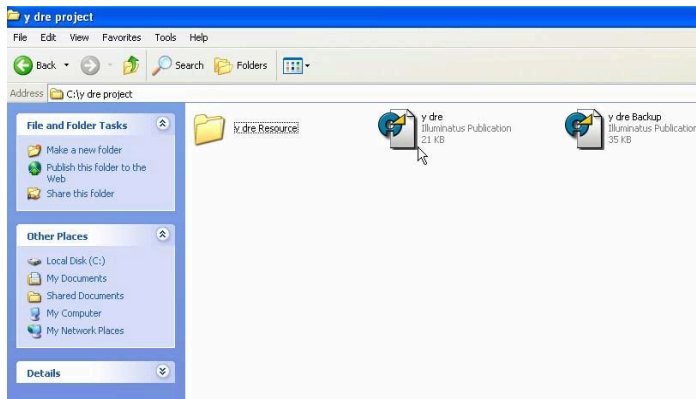


20. Now we can actually open our Opus publication and work on it on another computer.

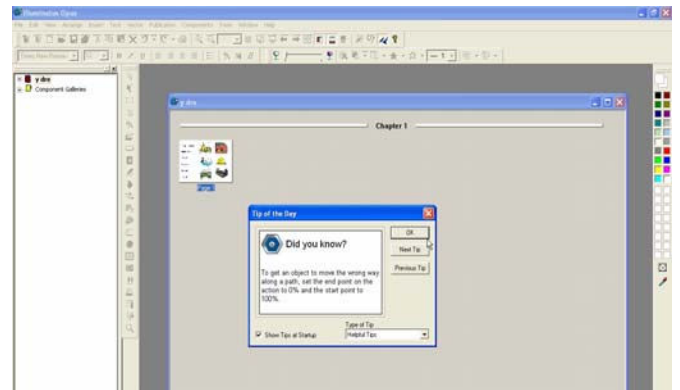
One way to do this is to click twice on the folder containing the publication.

21. The folder will contain 3 items: a resources folder, a publication and the publication backup file. Click twice on the Publication—in this case it is called 'y dre'.



22. Illuminatus Opus will automatically start up with a tip of the day and your page shown in a thumbnail view. Close the tip of the day and click twice on the thumbnail to open the page. Alternatively you can open the page by going to the organiser and clicking on the plus next to the black book, the plus next to the chapter, then double click on the page you want to work on.
